Attendance Requirement for End Semester Exam June 2022

20 May 2022

This is further to the notification dated 6 May 2022 related to issue of Admit Card etc. As per the attendance requirement of the University a student is eligible to take the End Semester Exam (ESE) only if the attendance for the subject is at least 75% or above.

However, the University has decided to give a further relaxation of 15%. Therefore, in order to take the ESE a student is required to have at least 60% attendance in the subject otherwise the student would be debarred from the ESE of that particular subject. This relaxation is applicable only for this Semester.

A student who is debarred in a particular subject can only take and pass the subject in Summer 2 examinations under Repeat category. Under Repeat category student's previous marks stand cancelled and the student is required to attend three weeks of classes followed by internal & external assessments.

Timelines to Issue Admit Cards – (Provided you have applied for the Admit Card & the document verification process is complete)

- BHM 2nd Semester students would be issued the Admit Cards latest by 27 May. For the
 Practical exam commencing from 23 May, if any student does not meet the Attendance
 requirement (& hence debarred) then they would be communicated of the same by the
 Dean's Office by 21 May.
- 2. SET Students Latest by 27 May
- 3. SoB Latest by 31 May
- 4. SAA, SoD, SHS, SOL, SPD & VHTBS students- Latest by 1st June
- 5. Ph.D 1st Semester 20 June
- 6. B.Pharm 2nd Semester latest by 30 June (For the TDCC exam scheduled on 8 June permission slips (if meeting the requirement) would be sent to the SHS Dean's Office by 6th June from where it has to be physically collected.
