Applications are invited in the prescribed form (attached) for Merit scholarship from eligible students based on ESE Jun/ Jul / Aug 2022 results for 2018 to 2021 batches. **The form is to be submitted latest by September 12, 2022** in the Academic Affairs Office (D-103) or by email at priyankachoudhary@sushantuniversity.edu.in

No submissions will be accepted after the said date.

Following is the criteria (batch wise) & conditions for the scholarship:-

SGPA >9.5 in the previous semester 100 % of the tuition fee in the semester	Maximum 10 students in order of merit in a programme with batch size of 60 or more on-roll students
SGPA 9.0-9.49 in the previous semester 75% of the tuition fee in the semester	Maximum 5 students in order of merit in a programme with batch size of 30 to 59 on-roll students
SGPA 8.5-8.99 in the previous semester 50% of the tuition fee in the semester	Maximum 2 students in order of merit in a programme with batch size of 10 to 29 on-roll students
SGPA 8.0-8.49 in the previous semester 25% of the tuition fee in the semester	Nil students if the on-roll students in a batch are less than 10

2018 Batch Admissions (Following UG programmes - BALLB, BBALLB)	
Merit Based Scholarship Criteria	Conditions
Academic performance as mentioned below SGPA 8.5 in the previous semester – 10% of tuition fees SGPA 9.0 in the previous semester – 20% of tuition fees	Top 10 students of a programme with batch size of 60 or above Top 5 students of a programme with batch size of 30 to 59 Top 2 students of batch size less than 30

Some general conditions applicable for all Batches:-

1. Students must attain a minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects/courses and/or should not have been debarred from taking end semester examinations due to short attendance.
2. Students should have passed all the examinations in the first attempt in the previous semester.
3. Students should not have been involved in any act of indiscipline or any police case inside or outside the University during his/her period of study at SU.
4. Lateral entry students will not be eligible for merit based scholarship until they complete one semester at SU and fulfill all the conditions mentioned.
5. Submission of documents does not guarantee Merit Scholarship. There will be a short listing of candidates.
6. Students can avail only one scholarship/ fee concession at a time.
7. No student would be considered for scholarship without (or incomplete) application form.
8. Students from Nepal will not be eligible for these scholarships due to their special fees structure.
9. Students whose document verification process is incomplete would not be considered for any scholarship/ fee concession.
