

CHANCELLOR'S MEDAL APPLICATION FORM

Eligibility Criteria for Chancellor's Medal:

1. The Chancellor's Medal is for final year undergraduate students only.
2. Minimum duration of the course/program to apply for the medal should not be less than 3 years.
3. Any regular graduating student of the University may apply for the Chancellor's Medal.
4. The student must have passed all the subjects in the first attempt by fulfilling attendance criteria.
5. Any attempt at reappear/improvement would make the student ineligible for the medal.
6. The student must have completed the programme within the prescribed minimum duration without extension or study break.
7. Lateral or migration cases would not be considered for the medal.
8. There must not be any disciplinary case against the student.
9. All claims of the student must be supported by relevant documents/annexures.
10. Factorisation on the CGPA will be applied for B.Pharm students.
11. The decision of the committee will be final and binding.
