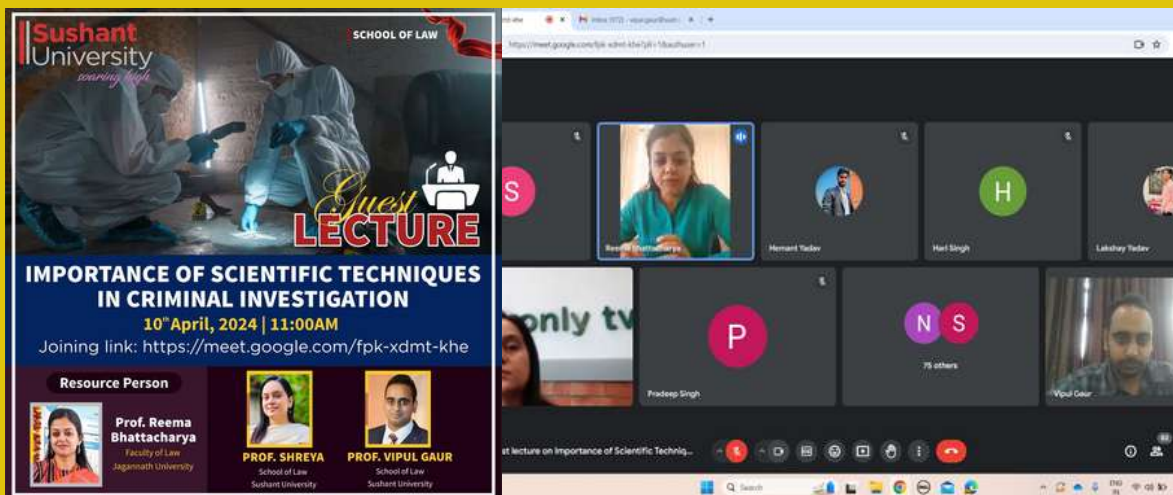
CLIENT COUNSELLING COMPETITION

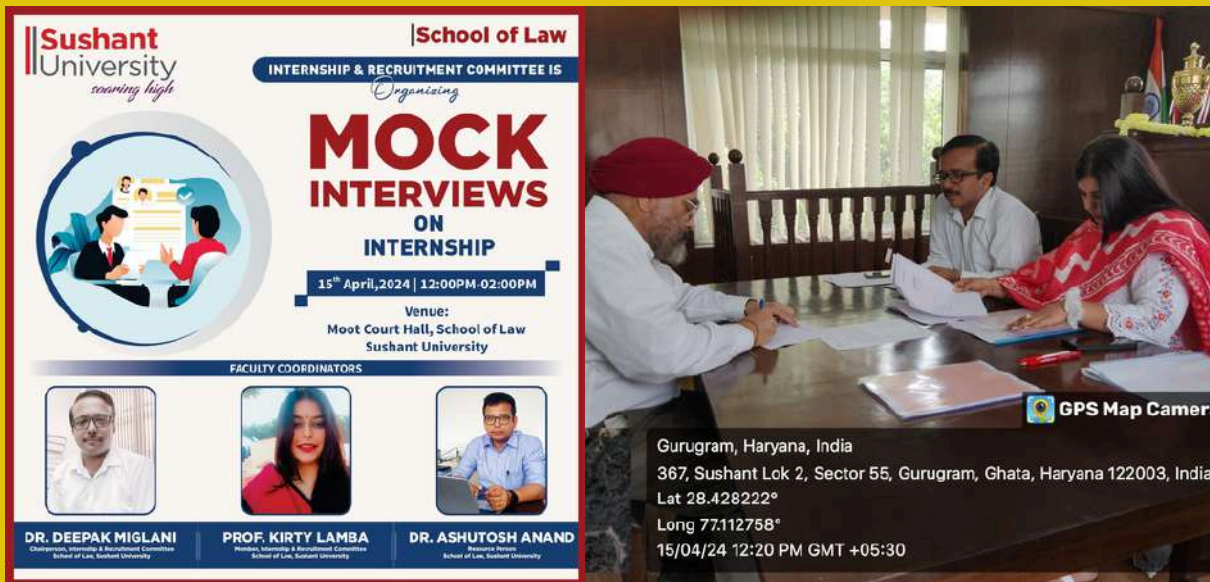

SEMINAR 9.0 CHANGING DIMENSIONS OF LAW: A MULTI- DISCIPLINARY APPROACH

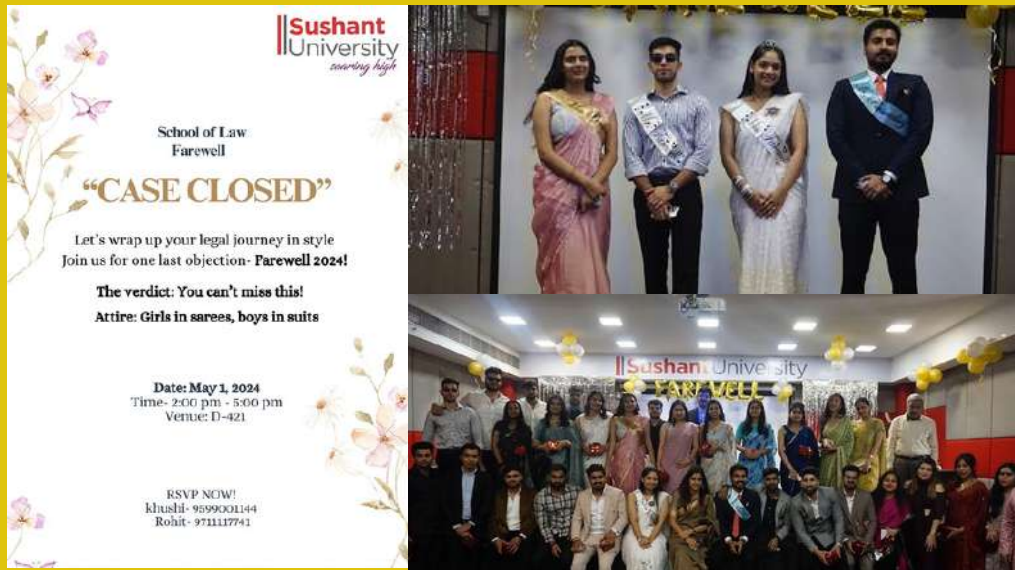

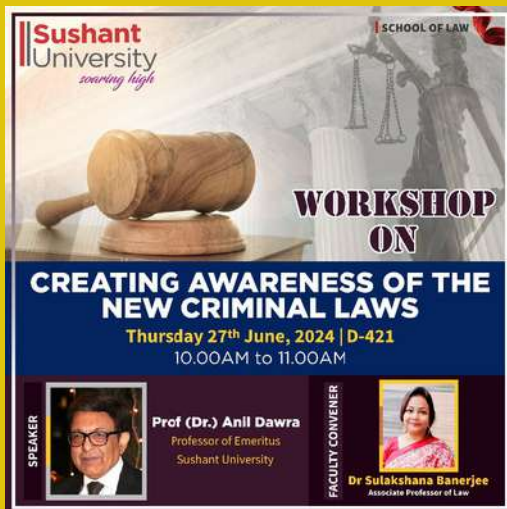
FAREWELL 2024
