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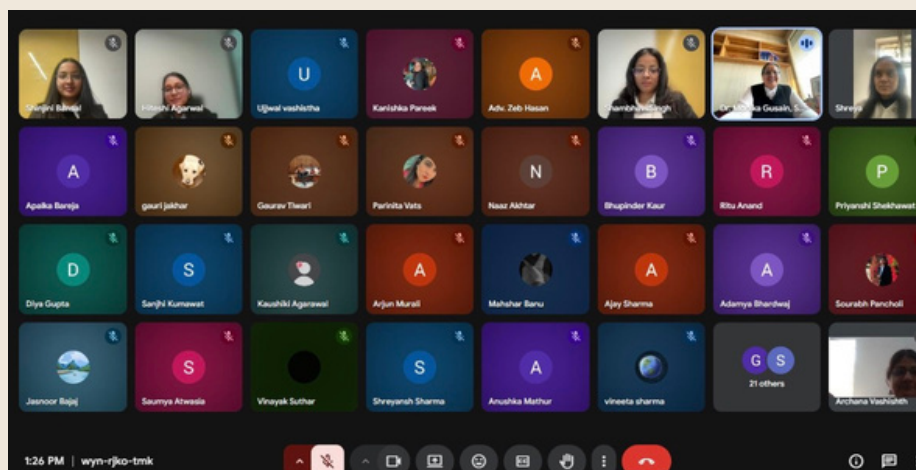
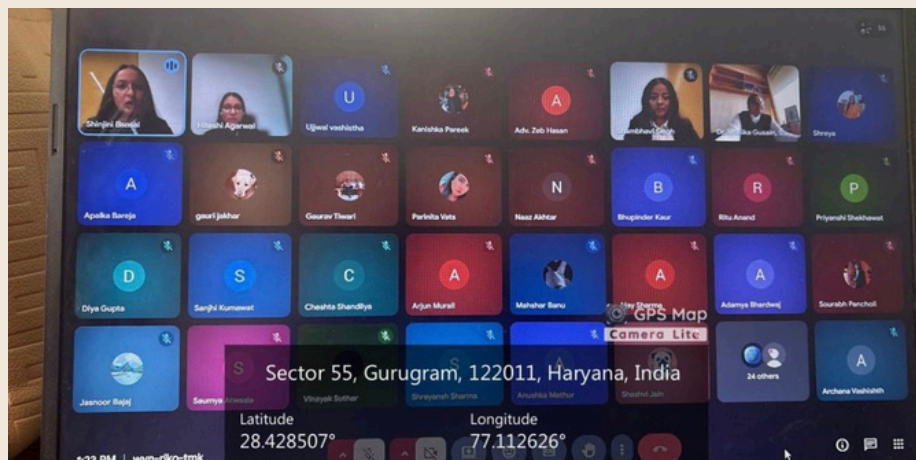

He emphasized that blockchain ensures transparency, decentralization, and security of data, while AI enhances these systems through automation, pattern recognition, and intelligent decision-making processes.

The Workshop successfully highlighted how legal professionals, technologists, and policy makers must collaborate to regulate and implement emerging technologies responsibly.
