

NOTICE – Special Provision of Repeat Category On-Demand Examination


The University is already offering On-Demand Examination for the Students who want to graduate in the normal period instead of putting in an additional year to clear their backlogs. The On-Demand Examination is restricted to external component only.

Several students have approached the University that they have pending non-final year subjects in which they have either not opted the subject during the initial offering of the course itself or were debarred due to attendance and have not cleared it despite multiple attempts. Such students cannot take the On-Demand Examination, therefore, as an exception, in favour of students graduating as early as possible, the University would permit such students to take a subject (non-final year subjects) in the repeat category.

(To be called '**Repeat On-Demand Examination**' [RODE] so that it is not confused with either the normal repeat category or the Not-Promoted Category Examination)

The charges for the same would be Rs 25,000 per subject. However, unlike the On-Demand Examination these subjects can only be taken during Summer Examinations that are scheduled by the University each year.

The RODE should not be considered as a shortcut by students to avoid attending regular classes; therefore, a student can take only up to two examinations each for Odd & Even Semesters respectively under this category.
