Notice: Application for Haryana Domicile Fee Concession for batch 2021-2022

Those students admitted in academic session 2021-2022 who belong to Haryana Domicile category and want to submit their claim for Haryana Domicile Fee Concession are required to submit their claim in writing in the enclosed form in Academic Affairs Office (D-103) or by email at priyankachoudhary@sushantuniversity.edu.in

The total income of the family of student from all sources shall not exceed Rs 6 Lakh per Annum.

Lateral / Migrating students admitted directly in the second year or beyond are not eligible to apply.

The application should be supported by the following documents:-

1. Haryana Domicile Certificate issued by the designated authority of the State/District.

- 2. For Government Employee / Non Government Employee: Form 16 under IT Act 1961, issued by employer or latest Certificate of the Annual Income of the parents issued by the designated authorities of the State/District, or copy of Income Tax Returns (with detailed Income Tax Computation as per Income Tax Portal) of the parents for the financial year 2020-2021.
- 3. 12th marksheet / Graduation Marksheet whichever is applicable.
- 4. Those applications where the document verification process is incomplete shall be summarily rejected. Check with your respective Dean's Office whether your process is complete in all respects or not.

Please note no application will be entertained without the above mentioned supporting documents.

All applications should be submitted to the Academic Affairs Office (D-103) or by email at priyankachoudhary@sushantuniversity.edu.in latest by 3 P.M. Monday, February 21, 2022. No applications shall be entertained after the due date under whatsoever circumstances.
