

GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW BY STUDENTS DURING KINGS CONCERT

24th February 2023

Event Time: 5.30 PM Onwards

Venue : Sushant Play Ground

GENERAL RULES

1. Regarding Entry Pass

- This event is exclusively for Students, Faculty, Staff and their invitee's apart from dignitaries and Authorities.
- Every student, their companion/parents/guests must carry his / her Identity Card and valid Pass provided to them while entering the campus and identify himself /herself with help of the Identity Card whenever asked for. Passes will be scanned for entry. They should be ready to show passes if asked anytime during event.
- The passes will be distributed from 18th Feb. 2023 by school coordinators. The organizing committee is not responsible in case of loss of pass. Pass will be issued only once.
- Entry is prohibited without pass. The time of entry will be informed 3-4 days before the event.
- Student's guest/friends / faculty/staffs and their guests also need to carry pass without which entry will be prohibited.
- > On the spot passes will not be provided at any cost.

2. Regarding vehicle parking

Students and Guests must park their vehicles outside university campus. Vehicles are not allowed in the campus.

All expressions or activities which are immoral, antisocial, communal and anti-national are

strictly prohibited

3. Regarding Checking at Entry

- Please do not carry sharp objects, inflammable objects or any other objects that might be potentially dangerous.
- Please do not carry/consume any intoxicant, liquor, any narcotics, drugs, cigarettes or additives or any sort. These are strictly prohibited within the campus.
- > Entry will be prohibited if found violating the rules.
- > At the venue even water bottle is not allowed to be carried.
- 4. Regarding Disciplinary Actions in case of Violation of Rules
 - > If any student or their friend or anyone else found violating any of these rules, will be dealt with strictness, would also be required to leave the premises immediately.
 - > Any misbehavior on part of the students will lead to expulsion from the university.
 - > Anything that can be perceived as being offensive to anyone or national and/or religious sentiments, gender, caste, race etc will lead to strict action.

- > The student's friends are their responsibility. If found guilty of misconduct, the SU student will also be held responsible and strict action will be taken.
- 5. Student or group of students found guilty in the event will attract one or more of the following actions by the university authority:
 - > Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - > Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
 - > Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - Withholding results
 - > Suspension/expulsion from the hostels.
 - > Cancellation of examination.
 - Rustication from the University
 - If need be, in view of the intensity of the act , a First Information Report (FIR) shall be filed by the University with the local police authorities.
