International student scholarships

Ansal University offers scholarships that covers the tuition fee in part and or in full for deserving international student. Our scholarships are to assist students from developing nations and to award outstanding achievers. Please note that our scholarships do not cover living expenses.

General Eligibility:

- > Must be a full time student in undergraduate or Post graduate course.
- Student must be holding a foreign country passport.

Application procedure:

This applies to all the first year International student opting for the International student scholarship program, the following criteria will be applicable for evaluating the application:

- Academic Transcripts (copies only) to support the record of sustained academic excellence.
- Copy of your passport.

Statement of Purpose:

A description of yourself, highlighting personal qualities, assets and liabilities that you feel will influence your education. Describe what you feel is your most important professional/academic achievement till date. Your goals & objectives of studying at Ansal University. How will the University benefit have you as a student? (Word Limit 1000 words).

> <u>Two Letters of Recommendation in Sealed Envelope:</u>

The letter must be written by a teacher/ Principal who knows the student for a period of at least two years. The letter must mention the capacity and the duration in which he/she has known the student. The letter should attest the student's character, capabilities and the track record of achievements and excellence through leadership roles. The recommendation has to be on the School / College/ Institute letterhead and duly signed along with the official stamp and seal of the School/ College/ Institute.



Conditions:

- 1. Ansal University International student scholarship provides an award annually to the recipient for up to four years, maximum eight semesters, or receipt of bachelor's degree (whichever occurs first) for undergraduate study. Students must have 50% and above in 10+2 to qualify for this scholarship.
- 2. International Student seeking scholarship at the time of admission need to follow the application process mentioned.
- 3. For Subsequent years, prescribed scholarship forms must be availed from Office of International Affairs in December and filled in forms must reach the office on or before 15 January of every year for scrutiny.
- 4. Renewal in subsequent year(s) depends on satisfactory academic performance and maintenance of hostel/university discipline, which will be reviewed at the end of each year.
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded in the form of a reduction in the tuition fee. The average value of the scholarship depends on the program undertaken, family income, funds available with the university to determine the scholarship, and applications received.
- 6. All scholarship applications will be scrutinized, and the scholarship committee will decide on the eligibility and quantum of scholarship.
- 7. Scholarship will only cover part of the tuition fee; the student must pay the remainder of the fee no later than the payment deadline.
- 8. Scholarships are available for Foreign Nationals, the student must: Hold a valid foreign passport with a valid visa to study at Ansal University.
- 9. Student cannot avail more than one scholarship simultaneously.
- 10. It is expected that you will dedicate yourself to your studies and successfully pass your course at the first attempt. Where you are not able to do this Ansal University scholarship will not pay for any fees associated with re-sitting exams or re-submitting written/practical work.
- 11. Ansal University can terminate the awarded scholarship at any time in writing, in the event of:
 - a) Misconduct, whether in connection with your study or otherwise.
 - b) Dismissal, for any reason, from Ansal university.
 - c) Breach of any local Indian law and practices.
 - d) Failure to comply with the conditions of your Indian Student visa.
 - e) The discovery that you have submitted fraudulent documentation.
 - f) You must not transfer to any other educational institution.



g) Circumstances, such as illness, arising which, with Ansal university's agreement, would render it impossible for you to complete your studies satisfactorily or prevent the purpose of the Scholarship from being fulfilled.

What happens if I breach a condition?

Any breach of your scholarship conditions is treated seriously and if you think you have breached a condition you should contact Office of International affairs immediately to discuss your situation. We would urge you to take prompt action to resolve any misunderstanding that may arise as a result of a breach, accidental or otherwise.
