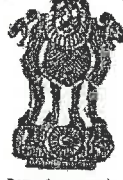

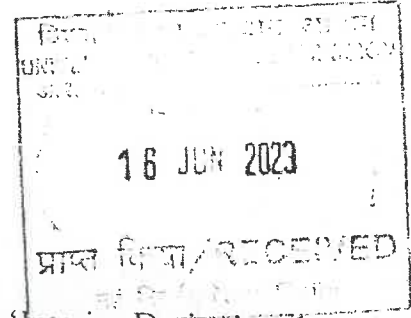

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this day 30 of June 2023 between School of Design, Sushant University, and **RVM BEYOND PRIVATE LIMITED & Its Subsidiaries**, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at 5R/5 NIT 5 Faridabad represented by its Authorized Signatory (hereinafter called "RVM Beyond", which term shall mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns of the First part)

### WHEREAS

1. School of Design (SoD), Sushant University, was established in 2010, following the success of School of Art and Architecture at the same campus. In the years since then, the School has acquired an excellent reputation for being one of the Best Design Colleges in India, with its progressive and global approach to design pedagogy and practice
2. RVM Beyond is the leading Ed-Tech and Skill Development Company which specialises in short-term Skill Development courses in various engineering and interior design fields. RVM Beyond has numerous Industry-linkages which ensures that placements of students and better career outcomes.

a) Whereas Sushant University is the leading university for imparting design and architectural training to students in North India, and provides long term as well as short term courses, including but not limited to, degree, diploma and certificate programs.

b) As per the RVM Beyond there is a huge demand of skilled manpower in the field of Interior Design and Fashion Design over the next years of rapid economic growth and this needs to be addressed by providing necessary training to youth to make them industry ready. RVM Beyond has various Skill Development programs in the field of Interior Design and Architectural Domain.

c) Technical training collaboration Sushant University & RVM Beyond and commence new courses/diplomas (NCRF Level 5) in the domain of Interior Design and Fashion Technology.

d) Sushant University & RVM Beyond stating that in order to keep the Sushant University trainers abreast with technology so as to enable transfer of requisites skills to students in view of adoption of Industry 4.0 technologies and proposed to conduct train the-trainers programme jointly in association with RVM Beyond in the areas of: i) Interior Design – 3D Software like Autocad, 3DS Max, etc. ii) Fashion Retail softwares

RVM Beyond & Sushant University are individually referred as 'Party' and collectively as 'Parties' under this MOU

**NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

**1. Objective:**

The overall objective of this MOU is to acquire and train students jointly by RVM Beyond and Sushant University to impart knowledge, skill & discipline required for manufacturing in line with Industry requirement and enhance the standard of its Training, Course content and new facilities. As per request of Sushant University, RVM Beyond shall provide student acquisition and training on software skills as per the agreed standards to the students of Sushant University as may be mutually agreed between the Parties. Sushant University shall provide infrastructure as well as impart theoretical training to students.

**2. Scope of the courses recommended by RVM Beyond:**

RVM Beyond recommends following courses under this MOU, which will be implemented by Sushant University in association with RVM Beyond to train students in employable skills as per Industry demand at Sushant University & any additional centres as may be mutually agreed between the Parties.

RVM Beyond recommendation is only of suggestive nature and does not bind RVM Beyond in any kind of liability. Sushant University shall decide on including RVM Beyond recommended courses in its syllabus solely based on its evaluation of usefulness of these training programmes and suitability for its students' capabilities.

RVM Beyond and Sushant University may add or remove courses based on market conditions on mutually agreed terms any time during the tenure of the MoU.

**2.1 RVM Beyond recommended Diploma/Certificate Course:**

**Interior Design Diploma**

- 12 Months Diploma (Level 5 of NSQF) by Sushant University and Training partner as RVM Beyond. Joint certification by SOD and training partner may also be given.
- 12 Months of course curriculum will be developed by Sushant University in consultation with RVM Beyond and in compliance to the UGC guidelines for B.Voc Programme.
- Students shall study CAD Design software at RVM Beyond Campus and theory component at Sushant university campus.
- The course delivery shall be designated as per vocational course policy as prescribed in the UGC guidelines for approval in BOS. Further the transportation between the campuses and training partner shall be borne by the students themselves.
- Fee for the diploma Course will be Rs 177,000 (including of GST if any), payable to Sushant University.

## Fashion Technology Diploma

- 12 Months Diploma with Joint certification – Diploma by Sushant University and Training partner as RVM Beyond.
- 12 Months of course curriculum will be developed by Sushant University in consultation with RVM Beyond in compliance to the UGC guidelines and approved by BOS.
- Students shall study CAD Design software at RVM Beyond Campus and theory component at Sushant university campus.
- Fee for the diploma Course will be Rs 177,000 (including of GST if any), payable to Sushant University.

Any fee discount or fee revision is subject to mutual discussion and agreement. Revenue Split between Sushant University and RVM beyond and shall be 60:40 in nature respectively. Revenue split will be inclusive of taxes if any.

Course fees and structure will be an **exhibit** and can be amended anytime without changing the overall MoU. Generally the course fees are hiked by 5-10% per annum on mutual agreement.

### 3. Role and Responsibility of Sushant University

Provide Trainers as well as Training Facility at Sushant University Campus for covering theory part of the diploma course curriculum. Salary of trainers / Faculty by Sushant University shall be borne by themselves.

Sushant University shall develop course curriculum with Team RVM Beyond for the joint diploma program.

Regular Maintenance of the machineries & equipments provided as a Training centers.

Sushant University shall bear all operational and administrative Expenses for imparting the theory/ partial aspect of the course.

Sushant University shall help RVM Beyond for marketing by allowing its infrastructure and trainers to be used for marketing purposes – recording video content, classes, etc.

Sushant University shall also assist RVM Beyond in imparting these courses online, webinars for value addition – by providing trainers to conduct online classes at RVM Beyond's dedicated website.

Sushant University shall work jointly with Team RVM Beyond for placements and internships of students after course completion.

#### 4. Role and Responsibility of RVM Beyond:

- Assist and provide training to Sushant University on creating course curriculum for the Training centers.
- Provide training on the CAD Software as a part of Course curriculum at RVM Beyond's campus locations in Faridabad.
- Provide training on the concept and methodology to be used by Sushant University for RVM Beyond Courses.
- RVM Beyond may also provide certification to the students on the software training it provides to students.
- RVM Beyond shall provide marketing of the joint training programs conducted by Sushant University and RVM Beyond on its Youtube channel and other social media platforms.
- RVM Beyond shall do student/trainee acquisition through its sales and marketing team - expenses incurred for student acquisition to be borne by RVM Beyond.
- RVM Beyond shall facilitate student placements through connecting with various industries, companies and arranging campus placements, RVM Beyond shall also have a full time placement coordinator for the same.

RVM Beyond confirms a minimum guarantee of 10 students in each of the two Diploma courses starting from 2023-24 academic year.


#### Payment Terms

- The total mutually agreed upon fees plan shall be paid by students on a quarterly basis.
- Payments shall be in favor of Sushant University. The students shall transfer money directly in Sushant University's escrow account or dedicated account.
- The revenue sharing percentage in the escrow account or by the manual distribution process shall be 60:40 in Favour of Sushant University and RVM Beyond respectively
- Till the escrow account is not active, the payment shall be manually distributed. The payment disbursement to RVM Beyond shall be disbursed in 7-10 days against every fees payment installment by the student in the planned programs.
- RVM Beyond will produce an invoice for the payment to Sushant university for the same.
- The Tax liabilities shall be individually borne by both of the parties with respect to the same distribution ratio.


#### 5. TERM AND TERMINATION

The Parties agree that the initial term of this MOU shall be effective from June 2023 and shall be valid for 36 months until June 2026.

After the initial term of 36 months this MOU may be renewed on terms and conditions mutually acceptable to the Parties







Either party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving the other party, six months notice in writing of its intention to do so. Both the parties may terminate this MOU without assigning any reasons for the same.

## 6. COPY RIGHT, PATENTS AND OTHER PROPRIETARY RIGHTS

All copyrights, branding rights (such as name of the Course etc.), patents and other intellectual property in the manuscripts, records, reports and other materials, except for the existing materials, publicly or privately owned, collected or prepared in the course of this MOU, shall remain the property of both the parties.

Sushant University undertakes that the material and other documents provided/ developed by RVM Beyond during the period of this MOU including but not limited to the Training Material shall be the property of both the parties and shall never be used for the benefit of any third party or commercial purpose by either parties.

Either Party shall not infringe any copyrights, designs, patents, trademarks, trade secrets and similar intellectual property rights of the other Party and any third party.

## 7. NOTICES:

All notices, requests and other communications under this MOU or in connection herewith, shall be given to the respective parties as follows:

## 8. REVIEW:

For smooth and effective functioning and implementation of the MoU, both the parties shall meet at regular intervals on mutually agreed dates and review the training program progress to initiate necessary action, if required to overcome bottlenecks / constraints in implementing the MoU.

## 9. OTHER CONDITIONS:

**9.1 Amendments:** This MOU shall not be amended except mutually agreed to by the Parties in writing.

**9.2 Confidentiality:** The Parties acknowledge and agree that all information whether in documentary mode or otherwise provided by either Party, with respect to the business and affairs of such Party, to the other Party, directly or indirectly, and whether oral or written, shall be considered confidential information. Each Party agrees that, without the prior written consent of the other party, neither it nor any of its affiliates shall: -

- a) Use any such confidential information of the other Party for any purpose other than in connection with this MOU; or

- b) Disclose any portion of such confidential information of the other Party to any person other than to persons who need such information in connection with this MOU; provided however, the foregoing restrictions on the disclosure and use of confidential information shall not apply to the extent that;
- i) Such confidential information became generally available to the public other than as a result of unauthorized disclosures;
  - ii) Such confidential information was received by the recipient on a non-confidential basis from a third Party prior to the recipient's receipt of such confidential information from the other party;
  - iii) Such confidential information was released without restriction to a third Party by the Party that has the right to such confidential information; or

i. The disclosure of such confidential information is required by judicial or governmental order or regulation.

All confidential information and any other material (including, without limitation, details of documents, models, database, designs, content, pricing and lists) furnished by one party to the other under this MOU are and shall remain the property of the disclosing party. Neither party shall share this information to any party outside this MOU without the explicit written approval from the other party.

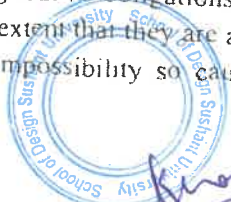
Upon termination of the MOU by either Party for any reason whatsoever, the Parties shall immediately cease the use of all information received from each other. This clause shall survive termination / cessation of this MOU.

**9.3 Dispute Resolution:** The parties shall endeavour to settle by mutual discussions, any claim, dispute or controversy arising out of or in relation to this MOU. That any claim, dispute, deadlock or controversy which cannot be resolved through discussions within 15 (fifteen) days or such extended period as the parties may unanimously agree, a party may refer the claim / dispute or difference to arbitration as herein under provided in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration shall be held in Faridabad and by a mutually agreed arbitrator. The award so passed shall be conclusive and binding. Each party shall equally bear the expenses of arbitration.

**9.4 Entire MOU.** This MOU and the documents incorporated by reference herein, express the entire understanding of the parties hereto, and supersede all prior promises, representations, understandings, arrangements and MOUs between the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein.

**9.5 Force Majeure:** In the event that any of the Parties hereto finds itself unable, by reason of a case of "force majeure" to carry out its obligations hereunder in whole or in part, the obligations of such Party to the extent that they are affected by such "force majeure" shall be suspended as long as impossibility so caused shall last but not

thereafter. The situation created by such "force majeure" shall be remedied as far as possible, with reasonable dispatch. The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on the date of signature below (effective date) by and between the American Institute of Indian Studies, an Educational and Research Institution located at 22, Sector-32 Institutional Area, Gurgaon (Haryana) (hereinafter called 'AIIS') and the Sushant School of Art and Architecture (SSAA) (AU), located in Gurgaon India which is a Department of Ansal University, established under the state legislation of government of Haryana, of May 10, 2012. (herein after called 'SSAA') and Whereas-

- A- "AIIS" and "SSAA" wish to develop academic exchanges of cooperation in teaching and research in furtherance of the achievement and dissemination of learning.
- B- "AIIS" and "SSAA" wish to co-operate to promote, facilitate and implement co-operation in the programs and activities as enumerated in the following articles:
  - 1- "AIIS" will send *scholars from US Universities* engaged in India Studies who are enrolled as doctoral, students or appointed as faculty in American Universities and wish to be associated / affiliated with SSAA for conducting field studies as well as collecting necessary research material, data etc. relevant to their topics of research study to SSAA. As under the FSIS (Foreign Students Information System) system, the unique ID for all foreign students has to be generated by the affiliating institution, the registration process will be taken care of by the affiliating institution. If required, letter of financial support and activities will be given by AIIS.



2- The duration of the scholar associated with the Sushant School will not be more than one year though the scholar may not use the facilities of SSAA full time during his/her stay in India. As the association with SSAA will vary from scholar to scholar depending on the Fellowship / award letter issued by the AIIIS, we have proposed two categories of scholars:

- i) Junior scholar
- ii) Senior scholar

AIIIS will pay onetime fee for each scholar to SSAA in Rupees as follows:

Rs.2500/- for junior scholar  
Rs.3500/- for senior scholar

- 3- The said scholars will spend time in SSAA (AU) who will issue a Certificate of Association (COA) in advance, which is a pre-requisite for the purpose of obtaining a Research Visa.
- 4- SSAA shall encourage and promote studies related to Art, Architecture and Design, Heritage Conservation. Both AIIIS and SSAA will undertake to assist each other in developing joint Performa, studying, seminars, workshops and special lectures at SSAA or any other venue as may be mutually decided.
- 5- The scholars enrolled may provide teaching assistance for the benefit of the students of SSAA on various allied subjects in the field of Art and Architecture.
- 6- The AIIIS can also avail the infrastructure and facilities (Lecture Rooms/ Studios/ exhibition space) of SSAA during weekends and holidays for conducting academic activities on payment of rent which may be mutually decided upon, based on the requirement and nature of event.
- 7- AIIIS may highlight SSAA student achievements such as best thesis and dissertation that are relevant for AIIIS on their website. Similarly SSAA may share and display visiting scholar's work, achievements and photos on their website and/or other digital and print media. In addition, AIIIS and SSAA may share relevant news and events highlighting each other's achievements and collaborative works undertaken. These will be displayed on respective websites with approval from both the parties.
- 8- Both the parties seek to develop collaborative activities in various ways including:
  - i) Exchange of Scientific, Academic and Technical information, appropriate academic materials and other information of mutual interest.
  - ii) Academic exchanges including mutual visits of faculty and students to pursue research and to lecture.
  - iii) Identifying opportunities for exchange and cooperation, joint research and development in disciplines of mutual interest.
  - iv) Organization and participation of joint-academic activities as seminars and conferences





- v) Joint projects on historical construction techniques especially pertaining to temples already documented and other architectural and heritage importance structures as a potential collaborative project.
- vi) Any other area of mutual interest which may be discussed and implemented from time to time by and between the parties.

9- Either party shall be entitled to publicize this understanding between them if it considers necessary relating to the subject matter provided that any press release and other materials approved as to the form and content by both parties in writing.

10- This MOU will come into effect from the date of signing of the understanding and will be valid until renewed or replaced by a fresh MOU.

11- This MOU can be terminated by either party at any time without assigning any reason, by giving three months notice to the other party.

12- Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation.

The above guidelines will serve as the first step towards the full cooperation of the two institutions. - The Confidential Information was already lawfully known, or became lawfully known to either of the Parties independently.
  - Disclosure or use is necessary by either of the Parties (including their employees, agents and sub-contractors) for the proper and effective performance of this MoU;
  - Disclosure is required by law to any Government, Governmental Department, Agency, Regulatory or Fiscal Body or Authority (whether national or foreign) and their Authorised Agents (including professional advisers);
  - The Confidential Information is disclosed, in the case of ISDC, to another member of the ISDC Group of Companies.



#### 4. Intellectual Property

Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute an agreement to transfer or license or to grant any Intellectual Property Rights belonging to one Party, as defined below, to the other Party.

- i. "Intellectual Property" shall mean and include all patents, trademarks, permits, service marks, brands, trade names, trade secrets, proprietary information and knowledge, technology, computer programs, databases, copyrights, licences, franchises, formulae, designs, logos, rights of confidential information and all other intellectual property.

  - a) In case a Party fails to initiate the Agreement terms in the specified period, for reasons not attributable to the other Party or reasons provided by a Party for the delay that are

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- not accepted by the other Party.
- b) Non-compliance of instructions received from a competent regulatory / court/ statutory/ supervisory authority and/ or if required under applicable law/s;
  - c) In the event of any breach by either of the Parties of any of the terms and conditions, obligations and undertakings specified herein, provided the Parties have not remedied/ rectified the breach within a period of 30 days of being notified of the same.
- iv. Any Party may terminate this Agreement if a force majeure event prevents such Party from carrying out its obligations for 30 continuous days. Termination under this Clause is permissible by giving a written notice of termination within 7 days of conclusion of the 30 days.
- v. On Termination, the Parties shall hand over to the other Party the possession of all documents, materials and any other property belonging to the other Party that may be in the possession of the Party or any of its employees, agents or individuals assigned to perform the activities under this Agreement.

## 6. Indemnity

The Partner hereby undertakes and agrees to indemnify WWF-India and its personnel, consultant, agents, and associated parties under this Agreement and hold them harmless and keep them at all times fully indemnified from and against all actions, proceedings, claims (including any claims raised by third parties), liabilities (including statutory liability), penalties, demands and costs (including without limitation, legal costs), awards, damages, losses and/or expenses however arising directly or indirectly, including but not limited to as a result of:

- i. Breach or non-performance by the Partner of any of its undertakings, warranties, covenants, declarations or obligations under this Agreement; or
- ii Any untrue statement or misrepresentation of a material fact contained in this Agreement or any document/ information provided by the Partner pursuant to this Agreement;
- iii Any negligent act or omission or default or misconduct or fraud of the Partner, its employees, agents, sub-contractors; or



