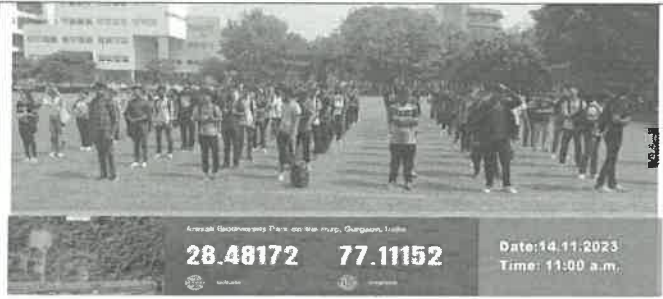


Fig 1: Students playing under Khelo India initiative

Sports Competitions and Highlights

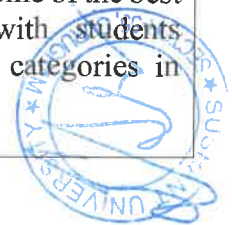

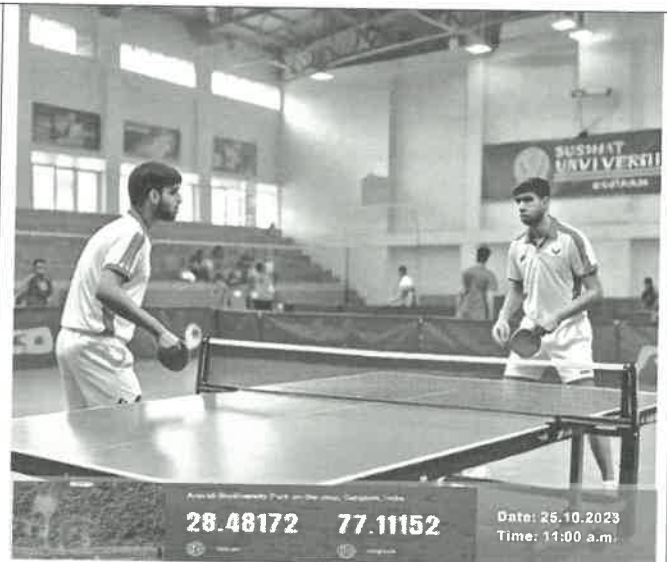


Fig 2: Table tennis Event at Sushant University

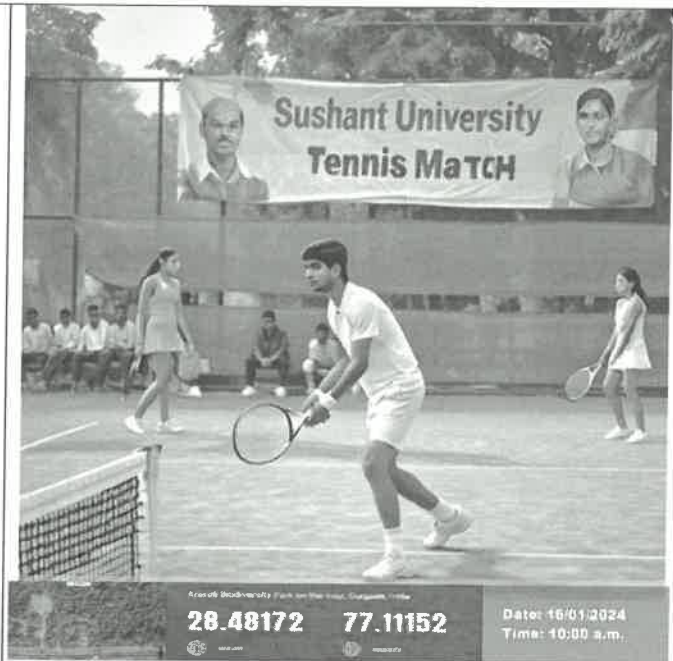


Fig 2: Lawn Tennis Match
