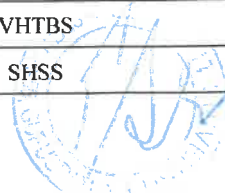

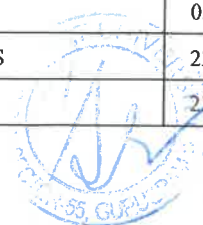



Report on Work-Life Balance in Academics

Integrating technology, including learning management systems and educational apps, enriches the learning environment and provides diverse instructional tools. 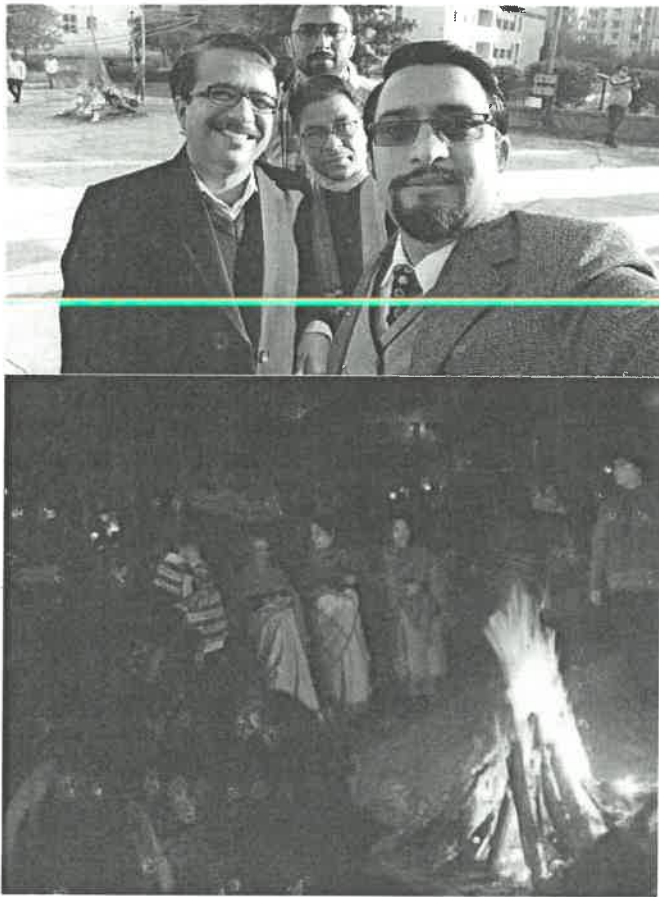
Title - Lohri Celebrations 2021

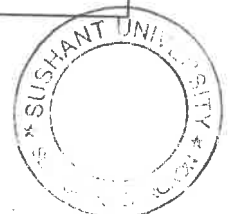
The School of Engineering and Technology celebrated Earth Day by hosting a National Level Poster Competition starting from 15th April 2021.


