It is poking and prying with a purpose"-Zora Neale Hurston On March 2, 2020, the School of Law, Ansal University organized a workshop on "The Art of Writing A Research Paper" which focused on to learning how to do legal research. Mr. Abraham Joseph was the guest speaker for the event. Mr. Joseph is currently working as a legal officer at Asian-African Legal Consultative Organization (AALCO). The workshop was opened to all the students of School of law and almost 45 were in attendance. During the workshop, the attendees shared their opinions, thoughts and problems regarding the legal writing. The workshop was divided in three aspects of legal writing and each part was thoroughly explained by Mr. Joseph. First Part was all about misconceptions about legal writing. Why do people don't write so often and what the golden rules of writing. In the Second part, the Five Stages of writing was explained. It covered the whole writing process of a research paper and how much time does each stage should be given. Lastly, we discussed what the meaning of legal research is, what the types of legal research are and how the objectives should and methodology should be written down.







The last point of discussion was Bluebook citation and how often it's not used correctly. During the workshop, the attendees shared the kind of problems they face during writing about any kind of legal topics. It was great to hear about the common pitfalls every researcher face and know that students are not only the one to face these kinds of problems. The workshop helped every student to feel much more confident in avoiding errors in any future project and made us a better legal researcher. 14.Outcome* The workshop on "The Art of Writing a Research Paper" held by the School of Law, Ansal University on March 2, 2020, proved to be a highly enriching experience for attendees. 
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

The primary objectives of the FDP were to:





The International Faculty Development Program (IFDP) titled "Rethinking Teaching Pedagogy in Commerce and Management" was conducted from July 3 to July 7, 2023, aimed at enhancing teaching methods and exploring new pedagogical trends in commerce and management education.

The inaugural session on July 3, 2023, began with a traditional Saraswati Vandana, followed by a welcome address by Dr. Richa N. Agarwal, the convener. Esteemed speakers like the Vice Chancellor of Sushant University, Prof. Rakesh Ranjan, and the Associate Dean of the School of Business, Prof. Vijay Anand Dubey, shared opening remarks. Each day of the program featured sessions moderated by a dedicated faculty member, ensuring an organized flow of activities and discussions.

Day 1, moderated by Dr. Richa N. Agarwal, commenced with Dr. William M. Hickey from Guangdong University discussing "Change in Trends in Teaching Pedagogy Post-Pandemic," reflecting on shifts towards digital and hybrid teaching models that have redefined educational practices. Following a lunch break, Dr. Suyash Bharadwaj from Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya presented a session on "Use of ICT Tools," highlighting technology's role in enhancing the interactive aspects of teaching. The day ended with a feedback session, gathering insights on the day's presentations.

On Day 2, moderated by Ms. Chakshu Mehta, the focus was on case study methodologies. Dr. Govind N. Srivastava from Jaipuria Institute of Management introduced "Understanding Case Study Teaching Pedagogy," emphasizing real-world applications in academic settings. In the afternoon, Ms. Sarvjaeta Verma, a NACRA reviewer and case author, expanded on "Case Study as an Effective Teaching Tool," sharing her expertise in using

case studies to promote critical thinking. A feedback session allowed participants to discuss and reflect on the effectiveness of case-based learning.

Day 3, under the moderation of Ms. Aanchal Dangwal, focused on aligning academic delivery with industry expectations. Mr. Anand Dhutraj from NL Dalmia Institute of Management Studies discussed the "Balancing Corporate Expectations and Academic Delivery." Following this, Dr. Mukesh Kumar from Marwadi University led a session on the "Critical Role of Research in Teaching," discussing the integration of research and teaching for a well-rounded academic experience. Feedback was collected at the end of the day to capture participant perspectives.

Moderated by Ms. Chandana Paul, Day 4 explored ethics in teaching. Dr. Rajneesh Kler from Amity University, Tashkent, led a session on "The Trinity between Ethical Pedagogy, Outcomes, and Assessment in a Multicultural Management Education Setting," highlighting the importance of ethics in diverse learning environments. This was followed by a session by Dr. Dhani Ram Agarwal on the "Role of Ethics and Indian Ethos in Teaching," which discussed the relevance of cultural values in pedagogy. A feedback session concluded the day.

The final day, moderated by Ms. Farhana Mariyam, centered on student engagement. Dr. Bharti Sharma from the International School of Informatics & Management discussed strategies for "Student Engagement and Assessment" in the morning session. In the afternoon, Dr. Prashant Pareek from Shanti Business School expanded on similar themes, further detailing assessment techniques. The day concluded with a valedictory address by Dr. Saurav Chhabra, followed by a vote of thanks from Dr. Richa N. Agarwal, and a final feedback session.

This IFDP provided valuable insights into innovative pedagogies, ethical considerations, and the integration of technology in teaching, emphasizing the importance of adapting to evolving educational demands.

Expert talk at School of Design Faculty FDP

This week-long event aimed to enhance research capabilities, foster a culture of inquiry within the design community, and align the faculty's research skills with contemporary design practices and methodologies.

- Industry-Academia Collaboration: The need for stronger ties between academic research and industry practices was highlighted, with strategies discussed for more effective knowledge transfer and collaborative projects.
- 4. Interdisciplinary Approaches: The value of crossdisciplinary research was a key focus, with faculty exploring ways to integrate insights from fields such as psychology, anthropology, and computer science into design research.
- 5. Research Ethics: Discussions on ethical considerations in design research, particularly when working with communities or utilizing AI and big data, were deemed crucial for responsible research practices.
- Publication Strategies: Faculty members gained insights into effective academic writing, targeting appropriate journals, and navigating the peer-review process in the design field.

Outcomes and Achievements



- 1. Research Clusters: Formation of five interdisciplinary research clusters focusing on themes such as "Inclusive Design for Urban Spaces", "Traditional Crafts in Contemporary Design", "Sustainable Materials and Processes", "Human-Computer Interaction in Design", and "Design for Health and Wellbeing".
- 2. **Research Proposals**: Development of 15 new research proposals by faculty members, with potential for internal funding and external grant applications.
- 3. **Skill Enhancement**: Post-event surveys indicated a 90% satisfaction rate among participants, with significant improvement reported in research methodology understanding and proposal writing skills.
- 4. **Collaborative Projects**: Initiation of three collaborative research projects between different departments within the School of Design.

- Resource Limitations: Concerns about access to advanced research tools and databases. Solution: Plans to enhance the university's digital library and research software subscriptions.

Recommendations

- Establish Design Research Center: Create a dedicated center to support ongoing research activities and collaborations.
- 2. **Launch Design Journal**: Initiate a peer-reviewed journal focused on design research, hosted by Sushant University.
- 3. Annual Research Symposium: Organize a yearly event to showcase faculty research and attract external collaborations.
- 4. **Research Skill Workshops**: Conduct regular workshops on specific research skills throughout the academic year.
- 5. **Industry Advisory Board**: Form a board of industry experts to guide research directions and ensure relevance to current design practices.
- International Collaborations: Pursue partnerships with international design institutions for knowledge exchange and joint research projects.

Conclusion

The Research Orientation for Design program at Sushant University's School of Design has successfully laid the foundation for a robust research culture within the faculty. The event not only enhanced the research capabilities of individual faculty members but also fostered a collaborative and interdisciplinary approach to design research.

The formation of research clusters, development of new research

proposals, and initiation of collaborative projects demonstrate the immediate impact of the program. The high satisfaction rate and increased confidence among participants indicate the program's effectiveness in addressing the research development needs of the faculty. Moving forward, the implementation of the recommendations will be crucial in sustaining and building upon the momentum generated by this orientation program.
