NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective:

The overall objective of this MOU is to acquire and train students jointly by RVM Beyond and Sushant University to impart knowledge, skill & discipline required for manufacturing in line with Industry requirement and enhance the standard of its Training, Course content and new facilities. As per request of Sushant University, RVM Beyond shall provide student acquisition and training on software skills as per the agreed standards to the students of Sushant University as may be mutually agreed between the Parties. Sushant University shall provide infrastructure as well as impart theoretical training to students.

2. Scope of the courses recommended by RVM Beyond:

RVM Beyond recommends following courses under this MOU, which will be implemented by Sushant University in association with RVM Beyond to train students in employable skills as per Industry demand at Sushant University & any additional centres as may be mutually agreed between the Parties.

RVM Beyond recommendation is only of suggestive nature and does not bind RVM Beyond in any kind of liability. RVM Beyond and Sushant University may add or remove courses based on market conditions on mutually agreed terms any time during the tenure of the MoU.

Any fee discount or fee revision is subject to mutual discussion and agreement. Revenue Split between Sushant University and RVM beyond and shall be 60:40 in nature respectively. Revenue split will be inclusive of taxes if any.

Course fees and structure will be an exhibit and can be amended anytime without changing the overall MoU. Generally the course fees are hiked by 5-10% per annum on mutual

The award so passed shall be conclusive and binding. Each party shall equally bear the expenses of arbitration.
- 9.4 Entire MOU. This MOU and the documents incorporated by reference herein, express the entire understanding of the parties hereto, and supersede all prior promises, representations, understandings, arrangements and MOUs between the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein.
- 9.5 Force Majeure: In the event that any of the Parties hereto finds itself unable, by reason of a case of "force majeure" to carry out its obligations hereunder in whole or in part, the obligations of such Party to the extent that they are affected by such "force majeure" shall be suspended as long as impossibility so caused shall last but not

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thereafter. The situation created by such "force majeure" shall be remedied as far as possible, with reasonable dispatch. The term "force majeure" as used herein shall mean any Act of God and any event, whether accidental or not beyond the will and control of the Party affected by such event (but not necessarily unpredictable) such as war, whether declared or not, riot, insurrection, civil commotion, sabotage, strikes, lock out, or other disturbances, accident, fire, earthquake, flood explosion, damage to plant or installations, epidemic, quarantine, restrictions, absence of the usual means of transport and embargoes. The Party affected by "force majeure" shall give notice thereof to the other Party by cable or fax or telex setting forth all necessary particulars concerning the giving of the said notice, the obligations of the Party giving such notice shall be suspended as said above and the Parties shall consult together with the view to determining mutually acceptable measure to overcome the difficulties arising there from.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Pursuant to the MoU dated 2nd June 2016 and 13th June 2019, both parties have agreed to extend the relationship and understanding for a further period of Three years from 13th June 2022 to 12th June May 2025.

BETWEEN:

AND

Sushant University, formerly Ansal University, is a private university situated in Gurgaon, National Capital Region, India. It was established in 2012 through the Haryana Private Universities Act 2012, represented by its Registrar; Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma hereinafter referred to as "Sushant University" or SECOND PARTY.

Both Parties as above have expressed a desire of entering a Memorandum of Understanding to meet their respective objectives, which are set out herein below.

WHEREAS

a. The First Party - ISDC, a Skill Development & Education Company having expertise in Professional and Vocational Education and is interested in associating with the Second Party to develop, promote and deliver B.Com. with ACCA which is integrated with the

b. - 7. The First Party provides additional training support/ master classes to the students enrolled for B.Com. with ACCA and the number of hours per subject / per module is given in the Annexure 1.
- 8. All responsibilities regarding registration of the students with ACCA should be dealt with, by the First Party. The students have to follow the Rules and Regulations of ACCA to appear in the examination and pursue the qualification/ membership and designation.

- 6. The First Party provides digital version of the relevant Learning Materials to the students enrolled and reference copy in physical form.
- 7. The First Party provides additional training support/ master classes to the students enrolled for B.Com. with ACCA and the number of hours per subject / per module is given in the Annexure 1.
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b) The Specified commercials does not include GST or any other tax components.

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- c) The mentioned fee to be collected by the University and paid to ISDC against the Invoice raised.

- 15. Where the collaboration reasonably requires the use by one Party of Intellectual Property that is owned by the other Party (the "IPR Owner"), the IPR Owner will license such

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rights to the other Party on a non-exclusive basis, without the right to sub-license, solely for the purpose and to the extent necessary in connection with the collaboration. Any such license will automatically terminate when the MoU is terminated.

- 16. For the purposes of this MoU, "Confidential Information" shall be all information of a confidential nature (whether written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of either Party which is obtained or received as a result of the discussions leading up to, the entering into or the performance of this MoU, including Financial Information, Training & Learning Material, Trade Secrets, University / College Lists, Trade and Commercial Details and Computer Software and Databases, the Contents of all Reports and Documentation prepared by either Party or on its behalf and any other information of a confidential nature designated by a Party as confidential; Each of the Parties shall at all times while this MoU remains in force and after it has terminated, keep confidential the Confidential Information except where:
- The Confidential Information was already lawfully known, or became lawfully known to either of the Parties independently.
- Disclosure or use is necessary by either of the Parties (including their employees, agents and sub-contractors) for the proper and effective performance of this MoU;
- Disclosure is required by law to any Government, Governmental Department, Agency, Regulatory or Fiscal Body or Authority (whether national or foreign) and their Authorised Agents (including professional advisers);
- The Confidential Information is disclosed, in the case of ISDC, to another member of the ISDC Group of Companies.
- Each Party undertakes to the other that it will not disclose or make use of, for its own benefit, any of the Confidential Information of that other Party.

17. All disputes and differences of any kind whatever arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be referred to the arbitration as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996

- vi. No deviation from the approved proposal and its activities will be permitted without written consent of the Parties.
- vii. The Parties to this Agreement shall not be liable to each other for failure or delay in the performance of any of their respective obligations under this Agreement for the time and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by riots, civil commotion, wars, hostilities between nations, government laws, orders regulations, embargoes, actions by the government(s) or any agency thereof, acts of God, storms, fires, accidents, strikes, sabotages, explosions, natural calamities arising out of or in the nature of a disease like COVID-19, or other similar or different contingencies beyond the reasonable control of the Parties to this Agreement.

2. Obligations of the Parties

i. Respect people's rights in accordance with customary, national and international human rights laws, including exposed groups such as children.

ii. Ensure compliance with all applicable laws relating to detection and punishment of fraud, bribery and corruption in India, including but not limited to the Prevention of Corruption

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Act 1988.

- iii. Respect and safeguard against employee discrimination, harassment, abuse of power, and gender in-equality in the workplace.
- iv. Respect and adhere to applicable labour laws in India to ensure health, safety, minimum wages and related benefits.
- v. Respect standards and agreements around confidentiality, including but not limited to the sharing of business sensitive information and personal data as protected by applicable legislation.
- vi. The Parties warrant that they have never offered, given or agreed to give to any person any inducement or reward (or anything which might be considered an inducement or reward) in connection with the entering into or carrying out this Agreement.
- vii. To the Parties' knowledge there is no conflict of interest with each other or their employees in connection with this Agreement. The Parties shall also promptly disclose in writing to each other any future conflicts of interest which could arise.
- viii. The Parties agree to inform each other of any breaches of the term of this Agreement on the part of either of them or any third party employed/ engaged by them.

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rights.

4. Intellectual Property

Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute an agreement to transfer or license or to grant any Intellectual Property Rights belonging to one Party, as defined below, to the other Party.

- i. "Intellectual Property" shall mean and include all patents, trademarks, permits, service marks, brands, trade names, trade secrets, proprietary information and knowledge, technology, computer programs, databases, copyrights, licences, franchises, formulae, designs, logos, rights of confidential information and all other intellectual property.
- ii. "Intellectual Property Rights" shall mean and include all rights, benefits, goodwill, title or interest in or to any Intellectual Property anywhere in the world (whether registered or not and including all applications for the same).

The Parties acknowledge and agree that they do not and shall not, nor shall they be deemed to acquire at any time hereafter and shall not claim or assert any right, title or interest whatsoever in the Intellectual Property of the other Party, as the case may be, or any combination thereof in any language, script or alphabet or take any action which shall or may impair the other Party's right, title or interest to the same.

Both Parties are prohibited from using the Intellectual Property of the other Party, without the concerned Party's prior agreement.

5. Term and Termination

- i. This Agreement comes into effect from 1st December, 2023 and is valid until two years from the date of the Agreement. The Agreement shall continue to remain in full force and effect during the said period unless otherwise terminated by any of the Parties as provided herein.
- ii. The Parties may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice in writing.
- III. Notwithstanding the aforesaid, the Parties may without any notice, terminate this Agreement under any one or more of the following conditions:

a) In case a Party fails to initiate the Agreement terms in the specified period, for reasons not attributable to the other Party or reasons provided by a Party for the delay that are

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not accepted by the other Party.

- Non-compliance of instructions received from a competent regulatory / court/ statutory/ supervisory authority and/ or if required under applicable law/s;
- c) In the event of any breach by either of the Parties of any of the terms and conditions, obligations and undertakings specified herein, provided the Parties have not remedied/ rectified the breach within a period of 30 days of being notified of the same.
- iv. Any Party may terminate this Agreement if a force majeure event prevents such Party from carrying out its obligations for 30 continuous days. Termination under this Clause is permissible by giving a written notice of termination within 7 days of conclusion of the 30 days.
- v. On Termination, the Parties shall hand over to the other Party the possession of all documents, materials and any other property belonging to the other Party that may be in the possession of the Party or any of its employees, agents or individuals assigned to perform the activities under this Agreement.

6. Indemnity

The Partner hereby undertakes and agrees to indemnify WWF-India and it's personnel, consultant, agents, and associated parties under this Agreement and hold them harmless and keep them at all times fully indemnified from and against all actions, proceedings, claims (including any claims raised by third parties), liabilities (including statutory liability), penalties, demands and costs (including without limitation, legal costs), awards, damages, losses and/or expenses however arising directly or indirectly, including but not limited to as a result of:

- Breach or non-performance by the Partner of any of its undertakings, warranties, covenants, declarations or obligations under this Agreement; or
- Any untrue statement or misrepresentation of a material fact contained in this Agreement or any document/information provided by the Partner pursuant to this Agreement;
- iii. Any negligent act or omission or default or misconduct or fraud of the Partner, its employees, agents, sub-contractors; or
- iv. Any act, deed, omission or non-performance on the part of the Partner or its employees or agents,

- v. Contravention of any law, as may be applicable from time to time, or industry practice;
- vi. Any accident occurring at the site of execution of the Project or in relation to the Project which leads to any physical injury or death of any employee, staff, personnel of the Partner or any third party

7. Confidentiality

Each Party shall consider as confidential all information provided by either of them under this Agreement which is designated as confidential by the other Party or which is by its implication clearly confidential provided that this Clause shall not extend to any information which was rightfully known to the other Party prior to the commencement of the negotiations leading to this Agreement or which is already in public domain or becomes so at a future date. The Parties hereby undertake not to divulge any confidential information to any person except to their own employees who need to know the same with respect to this Agreement. The Parties shall ensure that their employees are fully aware of and comply with the provisions of this Clause.

8. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the Laws of India that are in force.

9. Dispute Settlement

Any dispute or claim arising out or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled amicably between the Parties. In case of failure to settle amicably, the Parties may go for arbitration as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. In such case, the dispute or claim shall be settled by arbitration conducted in New Delhi by a panel consisting of two arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties, The award of the arbitration shall be binding and final.

10. Interpretation

In this Agreement:

- (a) Reference to any statute or statutory provisions shall include a reference to the statute or statutory provision as from time to time amended, extended or re-enacted.
- (b) Word importing the singular includes the plural, words importing any gender include every corporate and incorporate and (in each case) vice-versa.
- (c) The headings of the Clauses are for case of reference only and shall not affect the interpretation or construction of this Agreement.

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(d) Nothing in this Agreement shall be taken constituting either Party as an employee or agent of the other Party.

Any Annexurers, amendments or supplements attached hereto shall form an integral part of this Agreement. The relationship between the Parties is on a principal-to-principal basis.
