


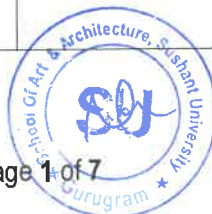

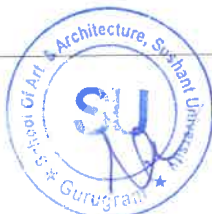

For architecture students, learning to capture the subtle details and grand narratives of buildings is crucial in their education. A specialized photography workshop focusing on capturing lesser-known monuments can provide students with the skills and insights they need to explore the rich tapestry of architectural heritage that often goes unnoticed.

### **Workshop Overview**

This workshop is designed for architecture students with a keen interest in photography and a desire to discover and document lesser-known monuments. Over the course of a weekend, students will learn the fundamentals of architectural photography, explore the stories behind hidden architectural gems, and develop a deeper appreciation for the cultural and historical contexts of these structures.

### **Objectives**



The primary objectives of the workshop are to:

1. Equip students with the technical skills required for architectural photography, including composition, lighting, and post-processing.
2. Encourage exploration and discovery of lesser-known monuments, fostering an appreciation for diverse architectural styles and histories.
3. Inspire students to tell compelling stories through their photographs, emphasizing the unique character and significance of each monument. Students will be introduced to the essential tools and techniques needed to capture stunning images of buildings. Key topics will include:

- **Camera Settings:** Understanding ISO, aperture, and shutter speed to achieve the desired exposure and depth of field.
- **Composition:** Learning how to frame shots effectively, considering elements such as lines, symmetry, and perspective to create visually engaging photographs.
- **Lighting:** Exploring the impact of natural and artificial light on



architectural photography and techniques for managing different lighting conditions.

- **Post-Processing:** Introduction to software tools like Adobe Lightroom and Photoshop for editing and enhancing images. This hands-on experience will allow students to apply the techniques learned on the first day and practice capturing the unique features of each monument. The field exploration will encourage students to:
- **Discover New Perspectives:** Look beyond the obvious angles and seek out unconventional views that highlight the monument's distinct characteristics.
- **Tell a Story:** Capture images that convey the history and cultural significance of each structure, considering how architectural elements reflect the monument's purpose and context.
- **Engage with the Environment:** Pay attention to the surroundings and how they interact with the monument, using elements like foliage; sky, and urban landscape to enrich their compositions.



Students will receive personalized feedback from instructors and peers, helping them identify strengths and areas for improvement in their work. The day will conclude with a mini-exhibition, where students will present their best images and share the stories behind them.

### **Conclusion**

This photography workshop offers architecture students a unique opportunity to enhance their skills and broaden their understanding of architectural heritage. By focusing on lesser-known monuments, students will not only develop their technical abilities but also cultivate an appreciation for the diversity and depth of architecture that lies beyond the well-trodden paths. Through the lens of a camera, students will learn to see architecture in new ways, capturing the essence of structures that might otherwise remain overlooked.

This report outlines the key findings, methodologies, and implications of this brief but intensive research endeavor.</p> <p>Introduction</p> <p>The Western Ghats, a UNESCO World Heritage site, is renowned for its rich biodiversity and is considered one of the world's eight "hottest hotspots" of biological diversity. This joint expedition aimed to conduct a rapid assessment of the region's flora and fauna, observe potential impacts of human activities on local ecosystems, and lay groundwork for future, more comprehensive studies.</p> <p>Objectives</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Conduct a rapid survey of plant and animal species in the selected study area</li> <li>2. Make preliminary assessments of local ecosystem health</li> <li>3. Identify potential areas for future, more in-depth research</li> <li>4. Propose initial conservation strategies based on the day's observations</li> </ol>



## Methodology

Given the time constraints, the research team employed a focused approach to data collection:

1. **Transect sampling:** Researchers established 2 linear transects, each 500m long, to survey plant and animal species.
2. **Camera trapping:** 5 motion-sensitive cameras were placed to capture images of wildlife.
3. **Water sampling:** Samples from 2 local water bodies were collected for later analysis.
4. **Drone survey:** A single drone flight was conducted to get an aerial view of the study area.
5. **Local guide interview:** Researchers engaged with a local guide to gather preliminary traditional ecological knowledge.

## Key Findings

### Flora

The expedition documented 37 plant species, including:

- 8 species of trees
- 12 species of shrubs
- 14 species of herbs
- 3 species of climbers

Notable observations include:

- An orchid species (genus *Dendrobium*) that requires further study for precise identification
- One plant species that is rare in the region

### Fauna

The team recorded sightings or signs of 24 animal species, including:

- 5 species of mammals
- 14 species of birds
- 3 species of reptiles
- 2 species of amphibians

Significant observations:

- Signs of the vulnerable Indian Giant Squirrel (*Ratufa indica*)
- Sighting of the Malabar Trogon (*Harpactes fasciatus*), indicating good forest health

### ### Ecosystem Health

The research team made preliminary observations on ecosystem health:

1. Some signs of habitat fragmentation at the edges of the study area
2. Presence of the invasive plant *Lantana camara* in disturbed areas
3. One instance of illegal tree cutting observed

### Conservation Strategies

Based on the day's observations, the research team proposes the following initial conservation strategies:

1. Further study to assess the extent of habitat fragmentation
2. Development of a management plan for invasive species control
3. Engagement with local communities for sustainable forest resource use
4. Enhanced monitoring to prevent illegal activities

#### Implications and Future Research

This one-day joint expedition has provided a snapshot of the area's biodiversity and laid the groundwork for future, more comprehensive studies. The observations underscore the need for continued research and conservation efforts in the Western Ghats.

Proposed future research directions include:

1. Extended surveys to fully document the area's biodiversity
2. Detailed study of the potentially rare orchid species observed
3. Long-term monitoring of the Indian Giant Squirrel population
4. Comprehensive assessment of human impacts on the local ecosystem

#### Conclusion

The collaborative effort between DY Patil Ajinkya University, Pune and Sushant University, Gurugram has yielded valuable initial insights into the biodiversity of this part of the Western Ghats. While limited in scope, this expedition provides a foundation for future research and conservation efforts.

The success of this joint venture demonstrates the potential of inter-university collaboration in addressing complex environmental challenges. It is recommended that this partnership continue with more extensive, long-term research projects in the region.



### **Day 2: Conservation Techniques and Case Studies**

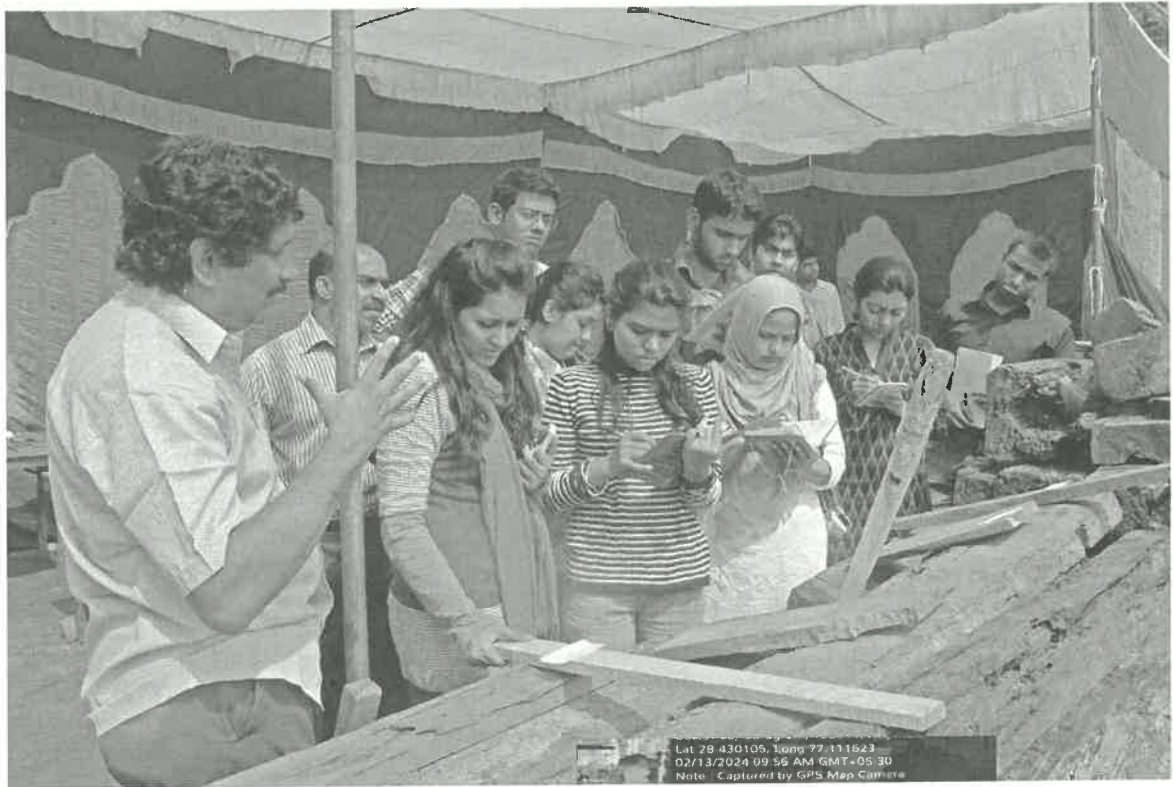

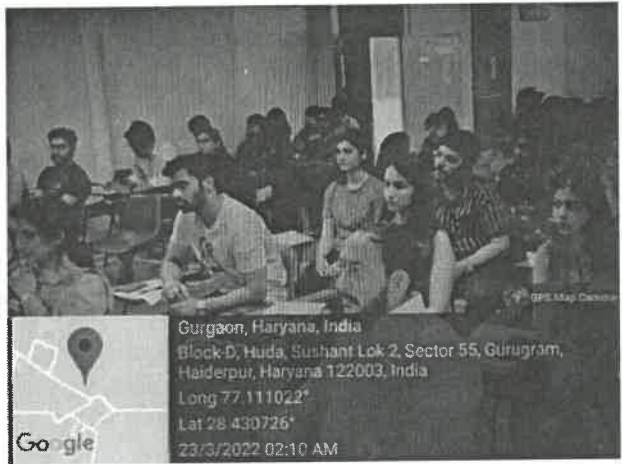
