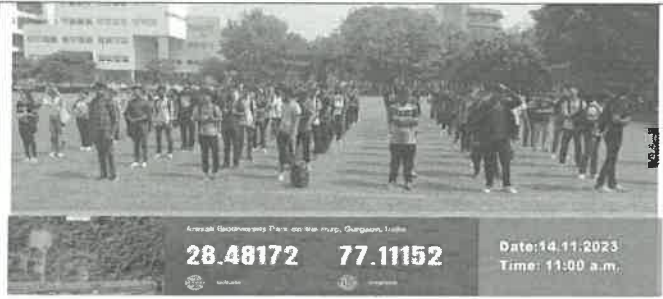

### **Sports Competitions and Highlights**

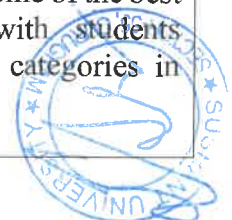
