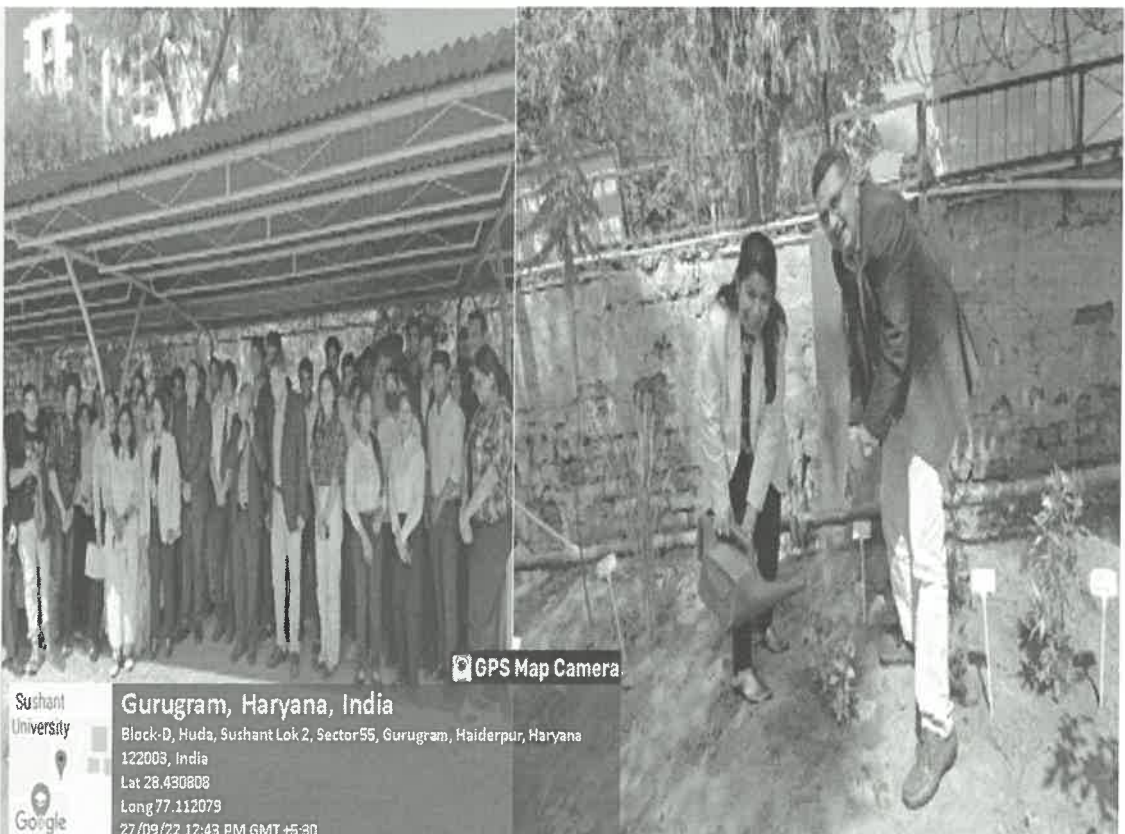


**Description -**
