The aim of the current study is to determine the impact of covid-19 on anxiety levels of college students. Researchers have shown that increased anxiety due to the fear of covid-19 had lowered the academic performance of college students. The data is collected with the help of Generalized Anxiety Disorder Scale (GAD-7) from the sample. GAD-7 scale is used to determine the anxiety levels of the sample. Sample size is 181 (78 males and 103 females) in the age group of 17-23. Data is collected with the help of questionnaire from the students studying in private colleges of Gurugram. 

To develop a framework for analysing urban livability, Lynch (1981) proposed the "Good City Form" idea (Patil & Patil, 2016). 
