
Interactive Sessions and Expert Insights:

The Program will be a three hour long interactive activity with girls and women, focusing on the following among various other aspects of cyberspace and related issues:












Description:

Ansal university invited Advocate Sapna malik from ABC legal firm to conduct a session on Sexual harassment at workplace for the students and faculty of Ansal university on 30th July 2019.

Can I hug my colleague at work without asking, or is this sexual harassment? Is it OK to comment on a woman's body?

When, in fact, does harassment start? It is helpful to note, from the start, that any form of harassment is usually humiliating and degrading and threatens the physical and mental integrity of a person. The Istanbul Convention of the Council of Europe defines sexual harassment as:

"any form of unwanted verbal, non-verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature with the purpose or effect of violating the dignity of a person, in particular when creating an intimidating, hostile, degrading, humiliating or offensive environment."

Parassment and sexual harassment are also defined in EU Directive 2002/73/EC16.

Harassment is said to occur "where an unwanted conduct related to the sex of a person occurs with the purpose or effect of violating the dignity of a person, and of creating an intimidating, hostile, degrading, humiliating or offensive environment".

Advocate Sapna enlightened the students and faculty about the laws of POSH and how to file a complaint against harassment and also made them aware about the importance of awareness about the same.




#### **Addressing Sexual Harassment in the Work Place**





### 2. Health Management and Lifestyle Adjustments:


