Deepdive into the world of Cyber Security

Cybersecurity refers to any technology, measure, or practice for preventing <u>cyberattacks</u> or mitigating their impact. Cybersecurity aims to protect individuals' and organizations' systems, applications, computing devices, sensitive data and financial assets against computer viruses, sophisticated and costly <u>ransomware</u> attacks, and more. Cyberattacks have the power to disrupt, damage or destroy businesses, and the cost to victims keeps rising. As per the recent study:

- The average cost of a data breach in 2022 was USD 4.45 million, up 15% over the last three
- The average cost of a ransomware-related data breach in 2022 was even higher, at USD 5.13 million. This number does not include the cost of the ransom payment, which averaged an extra USD 1,542,333, up 89% from the previous year.

The school organized a seminar for all the batches on introduction to the world of Cyber Security. The session was taken by Mr. Mayank Rathour, Digital Forensic Specialist, Forensic Guru. It was a insightful session for students and made them aware about the amazing field and career opportunities in the world of Cyber Security.
