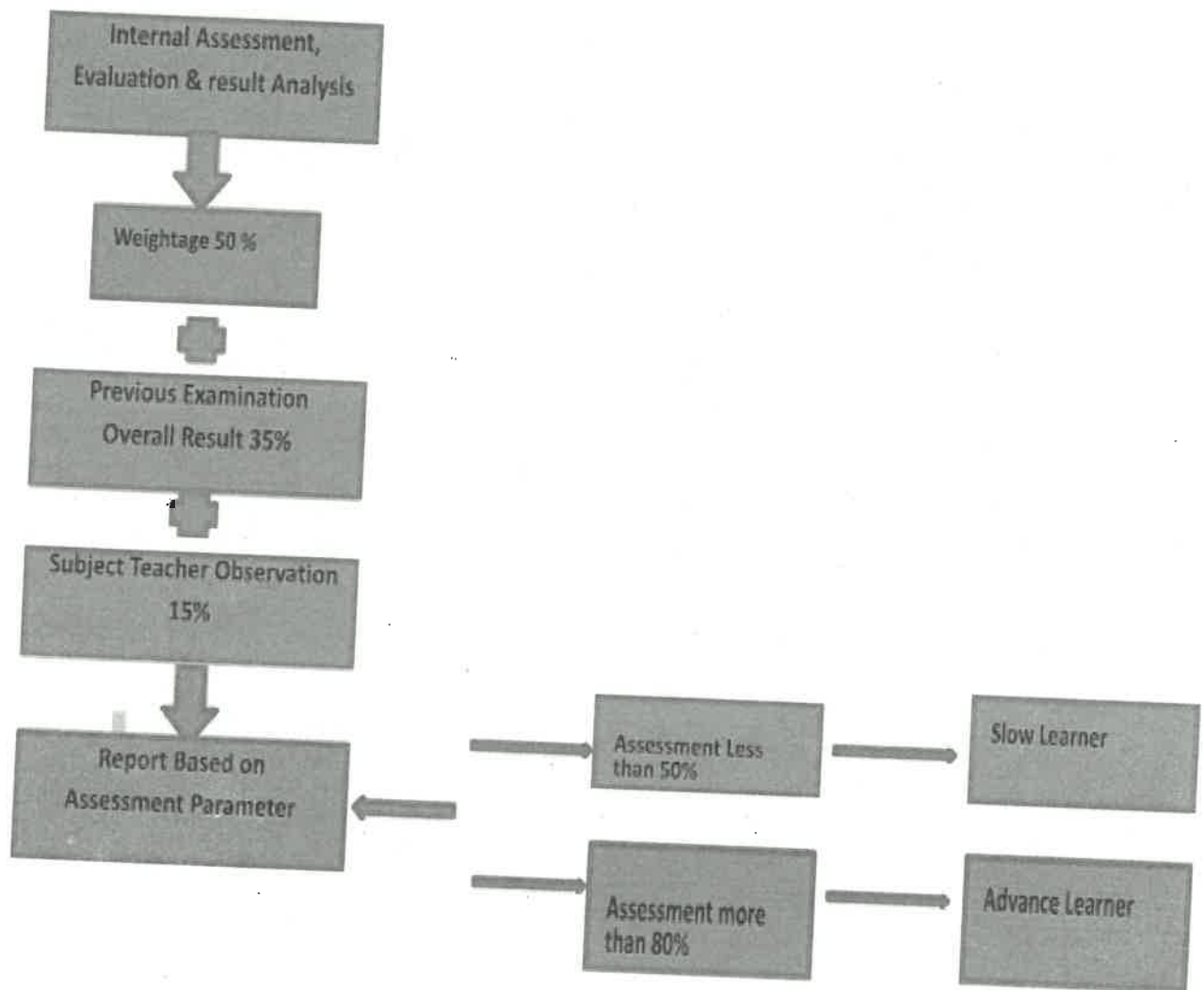

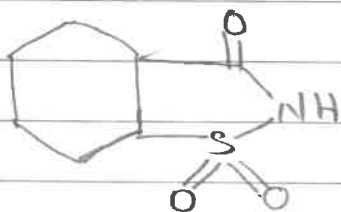

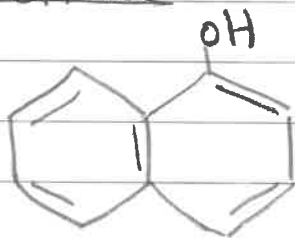

What is Gout?

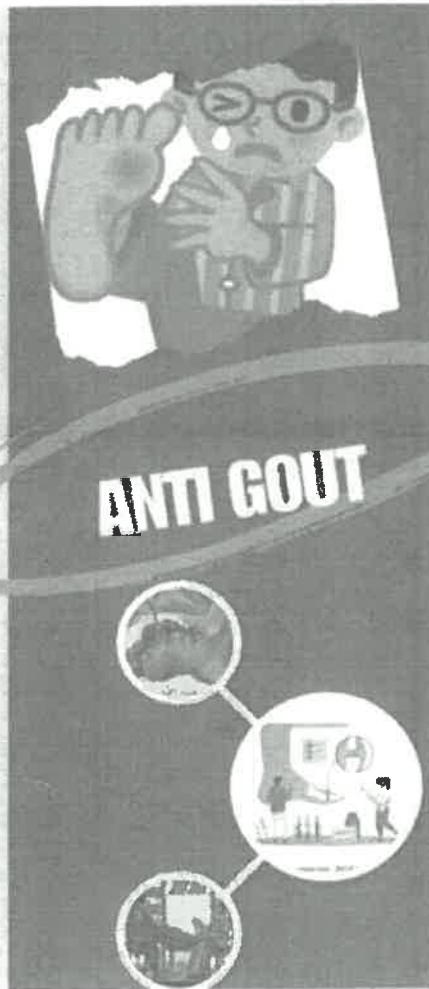
Gout is a form of arthritis caused by high levels of uric acid in the blood, leading to the formation of urate crystals in the joints. This results in sudden, severe pain, swelling and inflammation, typically affecting the big toe.

Purpose:

Anti-gout medications, such as allopurinol and colchicine, help to reduce the level of uric acid in the blood and relieve symptoms of gout, a condition caused by uric acid buildup in the joint.

Common Medications:

- Allopurinol: Reduces uric acid production
- Colchicine: Reduces inflammation and pain during acute gout attacks



Precautions:

- Take allopurinol after meals to reduce stomach upset.
- Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice with colchicine, as they can increase side effects. Stay hydrated to help reduce uric acid buildup.
- Do not stop medications abruptly unless advised by your doctor.

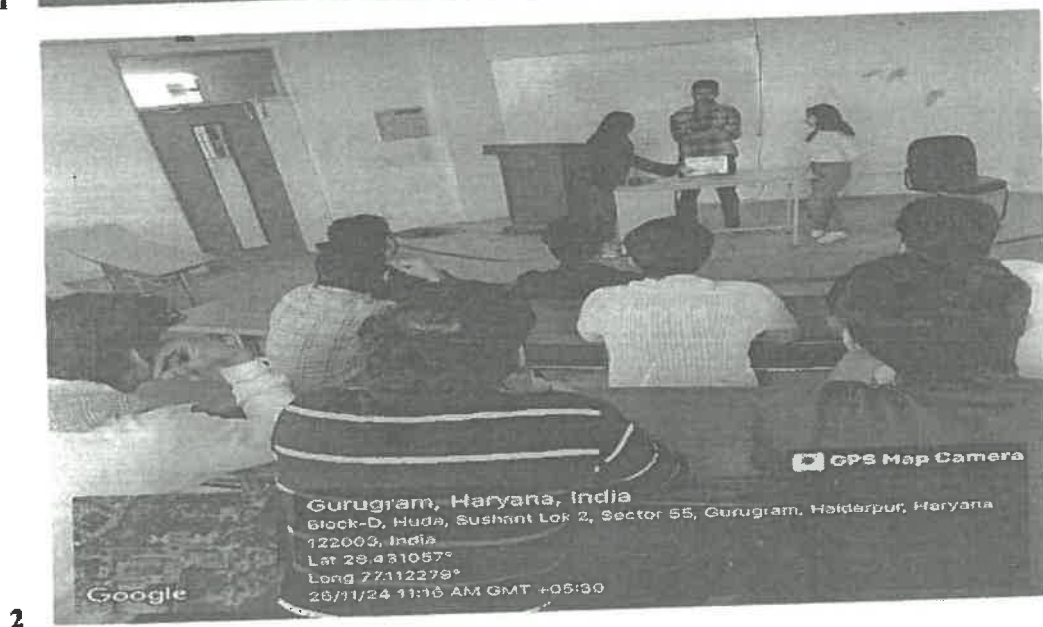

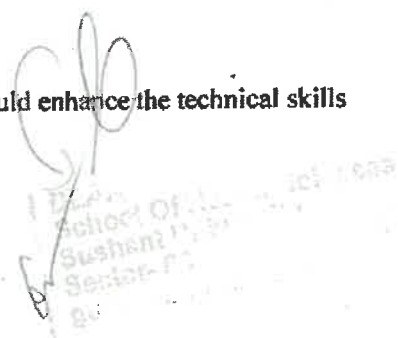
