

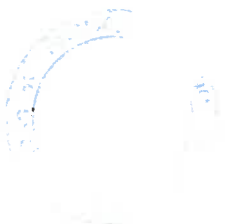

• Coca-Cola's budgetary control involves setting financial targets, allocating resources, and regularly comparing actual performance against the budget.

• This process aids in identifying variances, analyzing their causes, and taking corrective actions as needed.

• Effective budgetary control ensures that the company optimally utilizes its financial resources to achieve strategic objectives while maintaining financial stability.



• Overall, Coca-Cola's approach to budgetary control reflects its commitment to financial discipline, strategic planning, and the efficient allocation of resources to sustain its position as a leading player in the global beverage industry.

Coca-Cola India FY23 profit up 3.8% to Rs 460.35 crore; revenue rises 36%

Implementation of budgetary control

- 1. Revenue Forecasting:**
 1. Coca-Cola might have implemented a detailed sales budget, forecasting sales for each product (Coca-Cola, Thompson, etc.) in different regions.
 2. Regular reviews of actual sales against budgeted figures help in identifying variances, allowing for timely adjustments in marketing and distribution strategies.
- 2. Expense Management:**
 1. To control the 46.35% increase in total expenses, Coca-Cola could have set department-wise expense budgets.
 2. Periodic reviews of actual expenses against budgeted amounts enable management to identify areas of overspending and take corrective actions.
- 3. Profitability Monitoring:**
 1. The profit increase of 3.02% indicates that Coca-Cola has successfully managed its costs in relation to revenue.
 2. Budgetary control involves comparing actual profits against the budgeted profits, enabling management to assess the effectiveness of cost-control measures.

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- 4. Diversification and Other Income:**
 1. The 23.07% increase in other income suggests that Coca-Cola may have implemented strategies to diversify income sources.
 2. Budgets for non-operating income streams, such as investments or partnerships, would be crucial for evaluating the success of diversification efforts.
- 5. Continuous Improvement:**
 1. Coca-Cola may have established a feedback loop for continuous improvement, regularly assessing the effectiveness of budgetary control measures.
 2. Adjustments to the budget based on lessons learned and changes in the business environment contribute to ongoing success.

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Analysis of Budgetary Control at Coca-Cola:

- **Planning:**
 - A lot increase in revenue from operations (35.85%) and total income (35.54%) suggests that Coca-Cola set realistic and achievable revenue targets.
 - Coca-Cola's money plans seem to match their plan and it's working because they're making more profit and getting more money.



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- **Control:**
 - The company's ability to manage and control its expenses is crucial. With a 46.35% increase in total expenses, it indicates that some cost control measures may need attention.
 - Monitoring and controlling expenses are critical aspects of budgetary control, and the company might need to assess and manage cost drivers effectively.



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- **Performance Evaluation:**
 - Profit increased by 3.02%, which indicates effective management of costs in relation to revenue.
 - Coca-Cola made more money than it spent, which is good because it means they are making a profit.
 - Other income also increased by 23.07%, Coca-Cola makes money in different ways, which helps them do well financially overall.
- ☐ Coca-Cola is good at handling its money. They keep track of what they spend and make sure they're making more money than they're spending. That's why their revenue and profit have gone up.
- ☐ However, Coca-Cola needs to keep an eye on how much money they spend to make sure they keep making a profit. They should regularly check and change their budgeting plans to do even better in the future.
