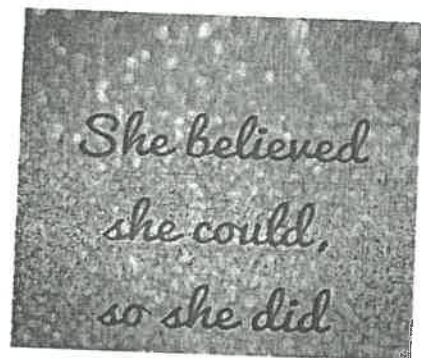
WHAT'S YOUR SUPERPOWER?
