## **Code Conqueror Club**

## Article I: Name

The official name of the organization shall be Code Conqueror Club (referred to as "the Club").

## **Article II: Mission and Objectives**

## Article III: Membership

Simultaneously, the gaming tournament engaged 25 squads and around 100 participants in high-energy matches, including BGMI, Call of Duty Mobile. Valorant, and Stumble Guys. This part of the event fostered teamwork, strategic thinking, and camaraderie. With about 150 attendees, HackPulse successfully balanced academic and recreational elements, promoting interdisciplinary collaboration. The event concluded with a prize distribution ceremony led by the Vice Chancellor, who praised the participants' dedication. The Zenith Club team ensured the club's commitment to fostering innovation and creating opportunities for student growth, highlighting plans for future engaging events. Participant feedback was overwhelmingly positive, highlighting the innovative format, practical AI integration, and the enjoyable balance between technical challenges and recreational fun.
