





The Impact of Supreme Court Decisions on Public Policy lecture provided an insightful look into the significant role that Supreme Court decisions play in shaping public policy and society. The session began by discussing some of the most high-profile Supreme Court cases in recent years and their lasting effects on laws and regulations across the United States.

One key case discussed was **Obergefell v. Hodges**, which legalized samesex marriage nationwide and demonstrated how Supreme Court rulings can profoundly alter social policy. The lecture explored how the Court's interpretation of the **Constitution** impacts broader issues, from civil rights to healthcare and education. Speakers emphasized that Supreme Court decisions can **set legal precedents**, influencing legislative action and guiding lower courts in future cases.

Decisions on topics like **abortion rights**, **gun control**, and **voting rights** have farreaching consequences for public policy and often spark national debates. The lecture noted that the composition of the Court, with its appointed justices, plays a critical role in determining the direction of public policy. The panelists discussed the growing trend of **judicial activism**—where the Court takes an active role in shaping policy—and the potential risks and benefits of such an approach. Finally, the session concluded by stressing the importance of **legal analysis** and the **Court's interpretive role** in ensuring that the Constitution remains relevant in addressing contemporary societal challenges.
