The lecture noted that the composition of the Court, with its appointed justices, plays a critical role in determining the direction of public policy.</p> <p>The panelists discussed the growing trend of judicial activism—where the Court takes an active role in shaping policy—and the potential risks and benefits of such an approach. Finally, the session concluded by stressing the importance of legal analysis and the Court's interpretive role in ensuring that the Constitution remains relevant in addressing contemporary societal challenges.</p>
