Minutes of the Meeting conducted on Monday, December 18, 2023, to review the recommendations of the committees constituted for the Career Advancement Scheme

A meeting Chaired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and joined by the Registrar was conducted on Monday, December 18, 2023, to review the recommendations of the two committees constituted on October 31, 2023, to evaluate the applications received from the faculty members for promotion under the Career Advancement Scheme(CAS). After a thorough screening of the recommendation reports submitted by both the committee, the following observations were drawn:

Creative Cluster

- 1. In the case of Dr. Sachin Dutt from the School of Design (SOD), although the essential qualification mentioned in the committee report was M.Design, still his case was recommended for promotion to Associate Professor without a PhD. However, It was verified from his documents that he is PhD as well as a Post-Doctoral qualification. Accordingly, his case was recommended for promotion to Associate Professor.
- 2. 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TO STRESS TEST OR NOT: A QUESTION FACED BY BANKS

Introduction

In today's era of liberalization and globalization , when there are extreme challenges on the shoulders of barks and financial institutions, who are to deal with more and more complex problems on a daily basis, stress testing is inevitable. Today, it makes sense that instead of doing financial projection on a "best estimate" basis, a company or its regulators may do stress testing where they look at how robust a financial institution or a financial instrument is. A stress test, is an analysis or simulation designed to determine the ability of a given financial instrument or financial institution to deal with an economic crisis.

Abank stress test in particular is a simulation based on an examination of the balance sheet of that institution or in other words it is a thorough analysis which is conducted under unfavorable economic scenarios to determine whether a bank has enough capital to withstand the impact of adversa developments:

The focus is on key risks such as credit risk, market risk, and liquidity risk. It aims to answer questions like;

- , what if a borrower fails to repay a loan or otherwise meet a contractual obligation?.
- What if you experience losses due to factors that affect the overall performance of the financial markets, from movements in market prices?
- What if a given security or asset cannot be traded quickly enough in the market to prevent a loss or make the required profit?

Siress texts can either be carried out

- · internally by banks as part of their own risk management, or
- by supervisory authorities as part of their regulatory oversight of the banking sector.

The results of stress tests depend on the assumptions made in various economic scenarios, which are described by the International Monetary Fund as "unlikely but plausible."

USE

Large international banks began using internal stress tests in the early 1990s Tests attracted a great deal of attention in 2009, as the worst global financial crisis since the Great Depression left many banks and financial institutions severely under-capitalized. In 1996, the Basel Capital Accord was amended to require banks and investment firms to conduct stress tests to determine their ability to respond to market events. However, up until 2007, stress tests were typically performed only by the banks themselves, for internal self-assessment. Beginning in 2007, governmental regulatory bodies became interested in conducting their own stress tests to insure the effective operation of financial institutions.

Since then, stress tests have been routinely performed by financial regulators in different countries or regions, to insure that the banks under their authority are engaging in practices likely to avoid negative outcomes. In India, legislation was enacted in 2007 requiring banks to undergo regular stress tests.

In October 2012, U.S. regulators unveiled new rules expanding this practice by requiring the largest American banks to undergo stress tests twice per year, once internally and once conducted by the regulators. Starting in 2014 midsized firms (i.e., those with \$10–50 billion in assets) are also being required to conduct Dodd-Frank Act Stress Testing.

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
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


