# Proposed Policy on Merit and other Scholarships and Haryana Domicile Fee Concession for academic session 2016-17

### 1. Merit and others Scholarship

Ansal University recognized excellence in education and encourages its students to do better in chosen field of study. In addition to Haryana Domicile Fee Concession university offers several kinds of scholarships on the basis of merit, performance in entrance test etc. These scholarships are designed to benefit broad range of meritorious students seeking admission in various UG and PG programmes.

#### General conditions applicable to the grant of Scholarships in each category:

- 1. Candidate will be required to pay full odd semester fee and the "scholarship amount awarded in the first year" shall be adjusted in the even semester fee.
- 2. The continuation/discontinuation of scholarship in subsequent years of study will be determined by (i) academic performance i.e. a minimum CGPA of 7.5 (ii) having faced no disciplinary action during the course of study (iii) attaining a minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects/papers.
- 3. Scholarships mentioned above will be applicable on the tuition fee.
- 4. Scholarship will not be paid in cash but will be adjusted with fee in subsequent years of study.
- 5. Candidate shall be considered only for one type of scholarship.
- 6. Lateral/Migrant candidates are also eligible for the scholarships based on their academic performance (i.e. CGPA).
  - \* Any other national level test.

## 2. Fee concession for Haryana domicile/resident students

As per Section 36 (2) of Ansal University Act;

25% of Haryana domicile/resident candidate based on their "merit-cum-means" shall be eligible for the following fee concession:

- (i) 5% out of the 25% shall be granted full fee concession.
- (ii) 10% out of the 25% shall be granted 50% fee concession
- (iii) The balance 10% of the 25% shall be granted 25% fee concession
- A. The following Standard Operating Procedure will be followed for the award of fee concession to the students enrolled under 25% of the Haryana Domicile category w.e.f. Academic session 2016-17.
  - 1. This fee concession is awarded on "merit cum means" basis. Merit will be considered first then means.
  - 2. Candidate whose parent's annual income is above 6 lakhs shall not be eligible for fee concession in Haryana domicile category.
  - Candidate will be required to pay full odd semester fee and the "fee concession amount awarded in the first year" shall be adjusted in the even semester fee.

### B. Applicability & Continuity of Fee Concession

- (i) Must meet the eligibility criteria for continuation of registration in terms of relevant Ordinance on "Course Credit Regulation and Grading System"
- (ii) Must meet the attendance criteria of Ansal University as per relevant Ordinance.
- (iii) Must not be suspended for any grave act of indiscipline as decided by the Disciplinary Committee of the Ansal University in terms of relevant Ordinance.
- (iv) No case of ragging against the student.
- (v) Must have attended all "Value Added" course for sharpening his/her career prospects.

### C. General conditions

- 1. Fee concession shall be reviewed yearly
- 2. Lateral/Migration entry admission shall not be considered for Haryana Domicile fee concession.

### 3. Reservation and relaxation to wards of Kashmir Migrants

The Kashmiri migrant's students will be provided following concessions during academic session 2016-17 in observance of UGC communication D.O. No, F.1-1/2012 (SA-III) dated 13 March, 2015 and D.O. No F.1-13/2010 CPP-II) dated 23 March 2015:

- (i) Relaxation in cut-off percentage up to 10 % subject to minimum eligibility requirements
- (ii) Two supernumerary seats in each course or 5% increase in intake capacity course wise shall be provided.
- (iii) At least one seat in merit quota shall be reserved in all schools of study in the university.
- (iv) Kashmiri migrant students will not be required to submit domicile at the time of admission.
