CHANGE IN REGULATIONS RELATED TO PASSING CRITERIA

(Applicable to all students {except B.Arch, M.Arch and Ph.D} who are yet to graduate from 2012 batch onwards)

A student has to fulfill the following conditions to pass any academic programme except B.Arch / M.Arch of the University:

- A student should earn minimum "D" grade in all courses separately. However, he/she can improve his/her grade ("D" grade onwards) by re-appearing.
- To pass a course, student must obtain 40% marks in the aggregate of Mid Semester Evaluation (MSE) & End Semester Examination (ESE). In order to pass a particular course, student must appear in the Final examination irrespective of the marks obtained in the Mid Semester Evaluation.
- For successful completion of a programme, the student should, at the end of final year of the Programme, secure a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of –

CGPA of 1.6 on a 4 point scale (applicable to 2012, 2013 and 2014 Batch) CGPA of 4.0 on a 10 point scale (applicable to 2015 Batch onwards)

(For courses of B.Arch / M.Arch there is no change in the Passing Criteria regulations.)
